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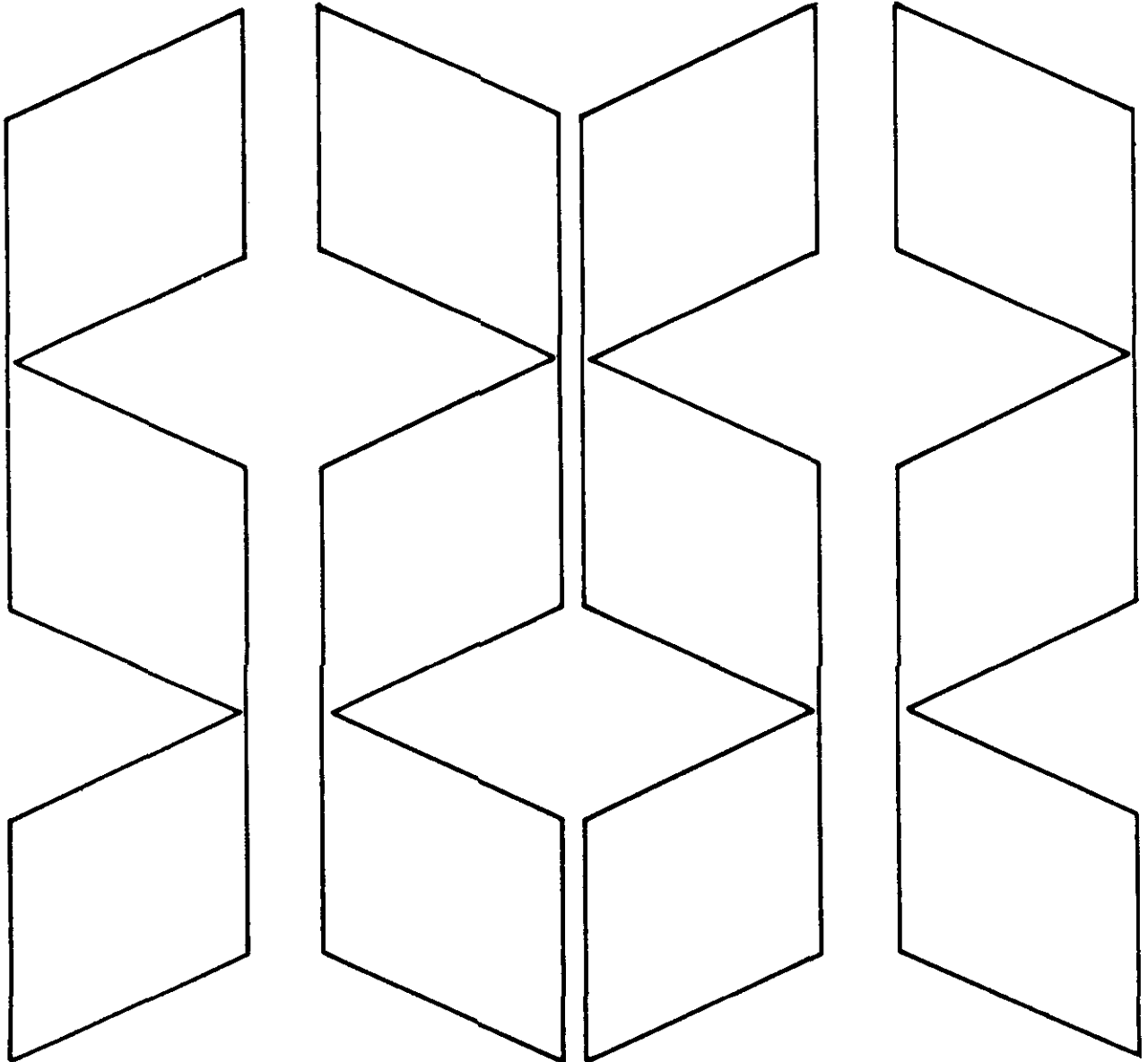

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# MEAT ANIMALS PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, AND INCOME 1985 SUMMARY



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## DEFINITIONS

**INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION:** Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equals the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

**INSHIPMENTS:** Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock for immediate slaughter.

**MARKETINGS:** Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter but live weight marketings shown in pounds exclude custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**FARM SLAUGHTER:** Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

**PRODUCTION:** Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, and any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

**PRICE:** State prices are as published in the February AGRICULTURAL PRICES report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

**CASH RECEIPTS:** Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

**VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION:** Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**GROSS INCOME:** Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

MEAT ANIMALS

Production, Disposition and Income  
1984-1985

Total marketings of meat animals decreased 1 percent during 1985. Additionally, lower prices received for cattle and hogs more than offset higher sheep and lamb prices, resulting in cash receipts of \$38.3 billion, down 6 percent from 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1985 were: cattle and calves, 75 percent; hogs and pigs, 24 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs and sheep were published in AGRICULTURAL PRICES, released February 28, 1986.

Production of meat animals during 1985 totaled 60.8 billion pounds, down slightly from the 1984 production of 60.9 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$30.4 billion in 1985 compared with \$32.0 billion in 1984.

CATTLE AND CALVES: Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves declined 6 percent during 1985 due to lower cattle marketings and lower annual average prices for cattle. For 1985, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$28.7 billion compared with \$30.7 billion in 1984.

All cattle and calf marketings during 1985 totaled 53.9 billion pounds, down 1 percent from 54.6 billion pounds in 1984. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$53.70 per 100 pounds live weight, was down 6 percent from 1984. The calf price for 1985, at \$62.10, was up 4 percent.

HOGS AND PIGS: Cash receipts for hogs and pigs were \$9.01 billion during 1985, 7 percent below 1984 and the lowest since 1980. Marketings of 20.3 billion pounds during 1985 were 1 percent below 1984, while the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight declined 7 percent from \$47.10 in 1984 to \$44.00 in 1985.

SHEEP AND LAMBS: Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1985 totaled \$503 million, up 8 percent from 1984. The average price of sheep in 1985 was \$23.90 per 100 pounds of live weight, up from \$16.40 in 1984. Lamb prices increased from \$60.10 in 1984 to \$67.70 in 1985.
