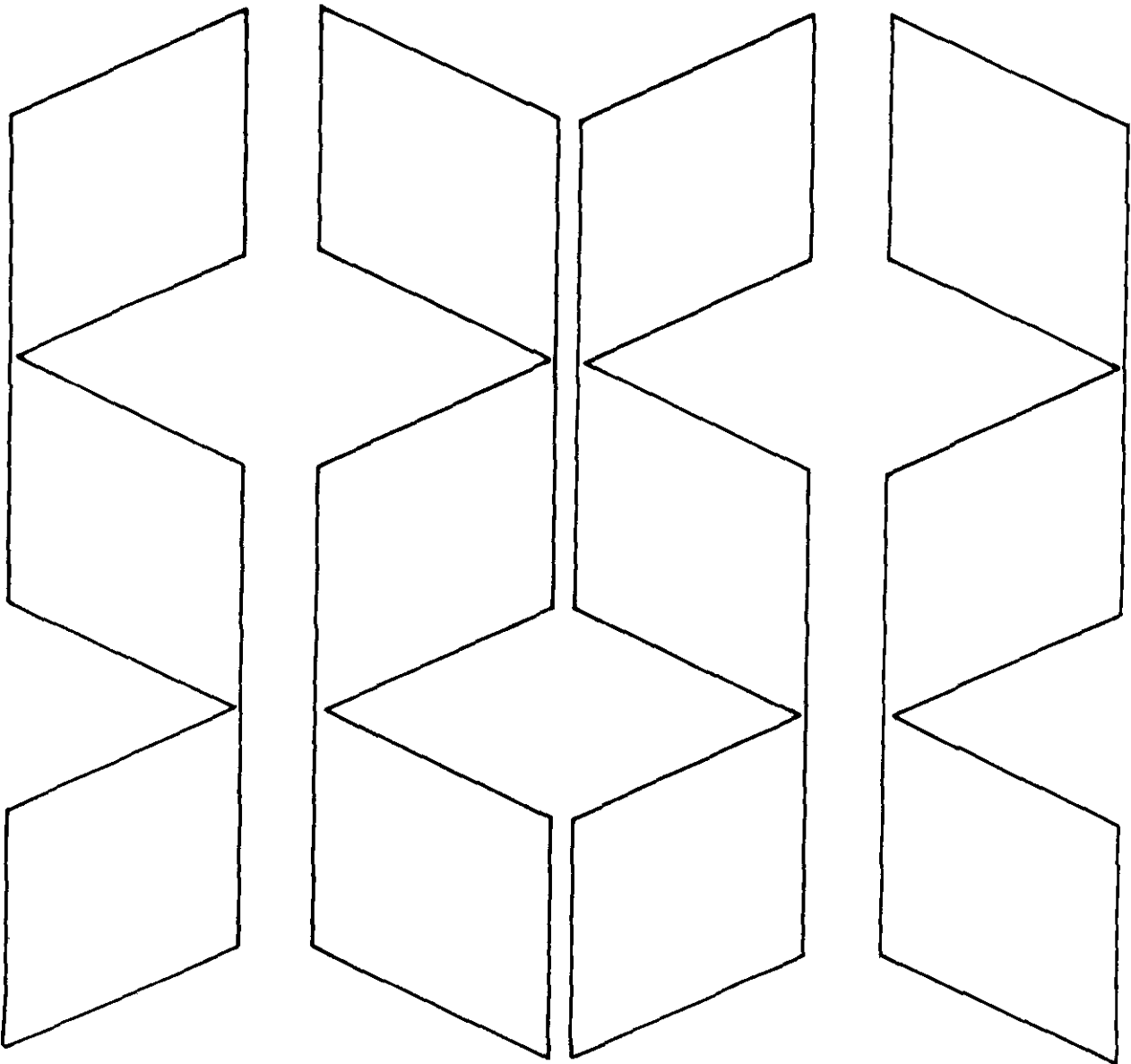
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Meat Animals Production, Disposition, and Income

1984 Summary



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DEFINITIONS

INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION: Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equals the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

INSHIPMENTS: Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock for immediate slaughter.

MARKETINGS: Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter but live weight marketings shown in pounds exclude custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

FARM SLAUGHTER: Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

PRODUCTION: Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, and any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

PRICE: State prices are as published in the February Agricultural Prices report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

CASH RECEIPTS: Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION: Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

GROSS INCOME: Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

MEAT ANIMALS

Production, Disposition and Income
1983-84

Total marketings of meat animals increased 3 percent during 1984. This, along with higher prices received for cattle, hogs, and sheep, resulted in cash receipts of \$40.8 billion, up 5 percent from 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1984 were: cattle and calves, 75 percent; hogs and pigs, 24 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs, and sheep were published in Agricultural Prices, released February 28, 1985.

Production of meat animals during 1984 totaled 60.9 billion pounds, down 2 percent from the 1983 production of 62.3 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$32.0 billion in 1984 compared with \$32.3 billion in 1983.

CATTLE AND CALVES: During 1984, higher cattle marketings and lower annual average prices for cattle led to a 7 percent increase in cash receipts from 1983. For 1984, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$30.6 billion compared with \$28.7 billion in 1983.

All cattle marketings during 1984 totaled 54.5 billion pounds, up 5 percent from 52.0 billion pounds in 1983. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$57.30 per 100 pounds live weight was up 3 percent from 1983. The calf price for 1984, at \$59.90, was down 3 percent

HOGS AND PIGS: Cash receipts for hogs and pigs was \$9.69 billion during 1984, a 1 percent decline from 1983. Marketings of 20.5 billion pounds during 1984 were 2 percent less than in 1983. The decreased marketings more than offset an increase in the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight from \$46.80 in 1983 to \$47.10 in 1984.

SHEEP AND LAMBS: Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1984 totaled \$465 million, up 9 percent from 1983. The average price of sheep in 1984 was \$16.40 per 100 pounds of live weight, up from \$15.70 in 1983. Lamb prices increased from \$53.90 in 1983 to \$60.10 in 1984.
