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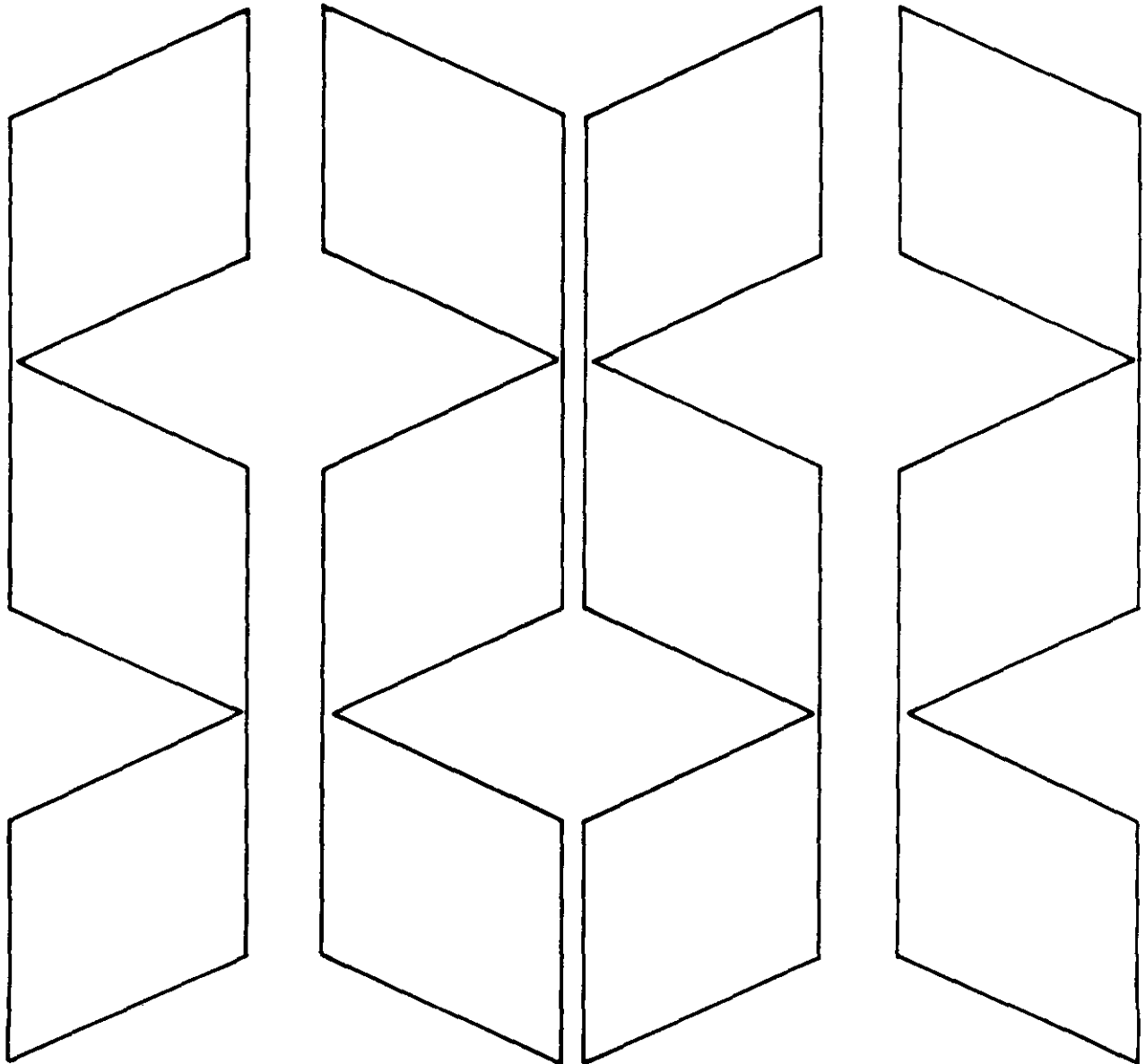

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# Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income

## 1987 Summary



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## DEFINITIONS

**INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION:** Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equals the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

**INSHIPMENTS:** Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock brought in for immediate slaughter.

**MARKETINGS:** Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter but live weight marketings (shown in pounds) excludes custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**FARM SLAUGHTER:** Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

**PRODUCTION:** Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, with an adjustment for any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

**PRICE:** State prices are as published in the February AGRICULTURAL PRICES report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

**CASH RECEIPTS:** Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

**VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION:** Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**GROSS INCOME:** Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

MEAT ANIMALS

PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, AND INCOME  
1986-1987

Total marketings of meat animals increased slightly during 1987 as decreased cattle marketings were offset by larger hog and sheep marketings. With higher prices received for cattle, hogs and sheep the resulting total cash receipts jumped to \$44.7 billion, up 14 percent from 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1987 were: cattle and calves, 76 percent; hogs and pigs, 23 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs and sheep were published in AGRICULTURAL PRICES, released February 29, 1988.

Production of meat animals during 1987 totaled 61.4 billion pounds, up 1 percent from the 1986 production of 60.6 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$35.6 billion in 1987 compared with \$30.9 billion in 1986.

CATTLE AND CALVES: Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves increased during 1987, as higher prices more than offset a decrease in marketings. For 1987, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$33.8 billion compared with \$28.9 billion in 1986.

All cattle and calf marketings during 1987 totaled 55.1 billion pounds, down 1 percent from 55.4 billion pounds in 1986. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$61.10 per 100 pounds live weight was up 16 percent from 1986. The calf price for 1987, at \$78.50, was up 28 percent.

HOGS AND PIGS: Cash receipts for hogs and pigs were \$10.3 billion during 1987, 6 percent above 1986. Marketings of 20.0 billion pounds during 1987 were 2 percent above 1986, while the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight increased 4 percent from \$49.30 in 1986 to \$51.20 in 1987.

SHEEP AND LAMBS: Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1987 totaled \$560 million, up 16 percent from 1986. The average price of sheep in 1987 was \$29.50 per 100 pounds of live weight, up from \$25.60 in 1986. Lamb prices increased from \$69.00 in 1986 to \$77.60 in 1987.
