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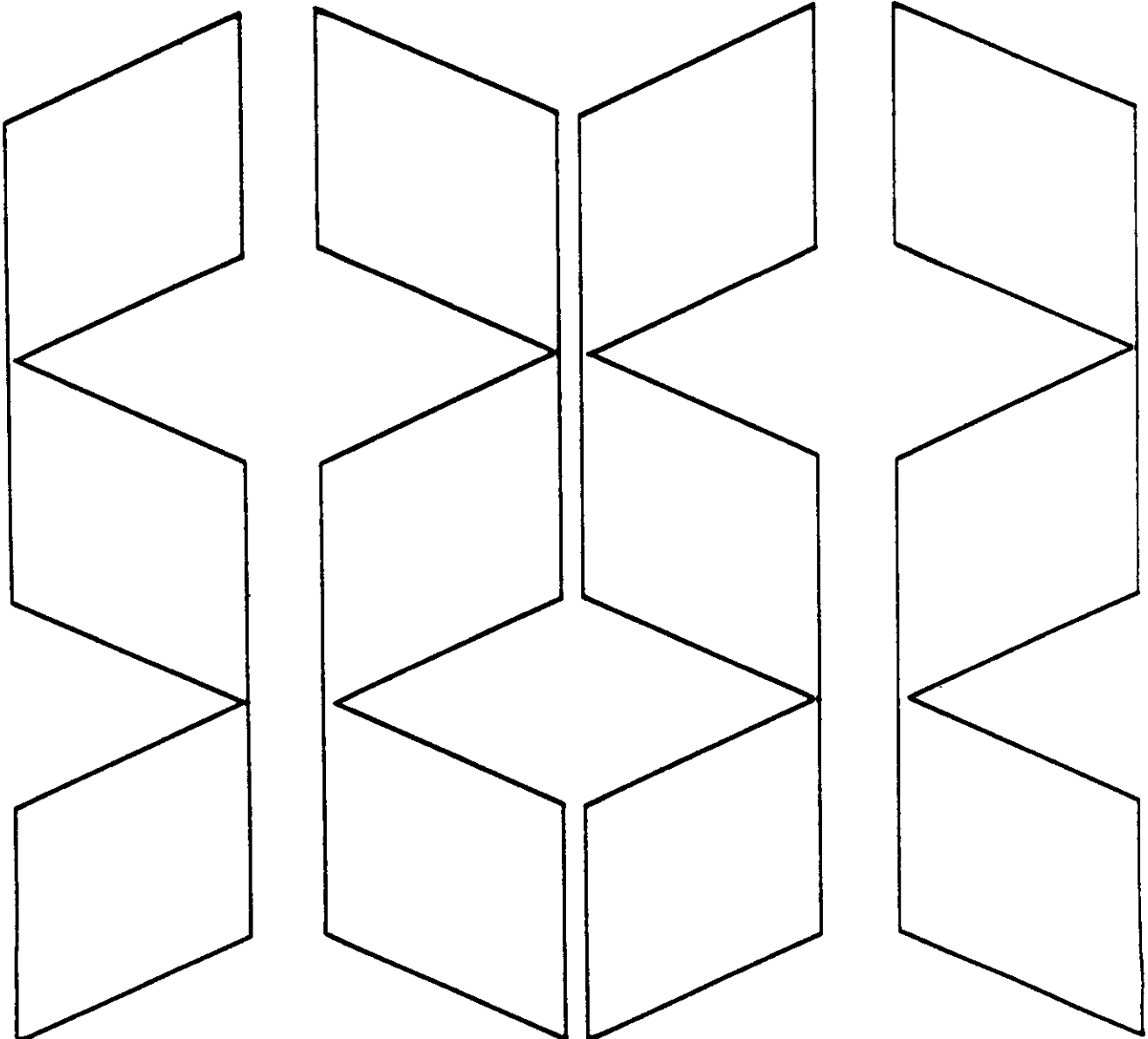
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Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income

1990 Summary



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DEFINITIONS

INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION: These are primary components of the balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of the year, births and inshipments equal the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of the year.

INSHIPMENTS: Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock brought in for immediate slaughter.

MARKETINGS: Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter, but live weight marketings shown in pounds excludes custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

FARM SLAUGHTER: Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

PRODUCTION: Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, with an adjustment for any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

PRICE: State prices are as published in the February **AGRICULTURAL PRICES** report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

CASH RECEIPTS: Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION: Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

GROSS INCOME: Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

MEAT ANIMALS
Production, Disposition and Income
1989-1990

Total marketings of meat animals during 1990 decreased slightly from 1989. Larger cattle and sheep marketings were offset by decreased marketings of hogs and pigs. Higher U.S. prices received for cattle and hogs and lower sheep and lamb prices resulted in total cash receipts increasing to \$51.7 billion, up 10 percent from 1989, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1990 were: cattle and calves, 77 percent; hogs and pigs, 22 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs, and sheep were published in **AGRICULTURAL PRICES**, released February 28, 1991.

Production of meat animals during 1990 totaled 62.8 billion pounds, down fractionally from the 1989 production of 63.0 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$42.2 billion in 1990 compared with \$37.8 billion in 1989.

CATTLE AND CALVES: Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves increased during 1990, a result of higher prices along with larger marketings. For 1990, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$39.7 billion compared with \$36.9 billion in 1989.

All cattle and calf marketings during 1990 totaled 53.0 billion pounds up 1 percent from 52.8 billion pounds in 1989. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$74.60 per 100 pounds live weight was up from the 1989 price of 69.50. The calf price for 1990, at \$95.60, was up from the 1989 price of \$90.80.

HOGS AND PIGS: Cash receipts for hogs and pigs were \$11.5 billion during 1990, 22 percent above 1989. Marketings of 21.4 billion pounds during 1990 were 4 percent below 1989, while the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight increased significantly from \$42.50 in 1989 to \$53.70 in 1990.

SHEEP AND LAMBS: Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1990 totaled \$412 million, down 16 percent from 1989. The average price of sheep in 1990 was \$23.20 per 100 pounds of live weight, down from \$24.40 in 1989. Lamb prices decreased from \$66.10 in 1989 to \$55.50 in 1990.
