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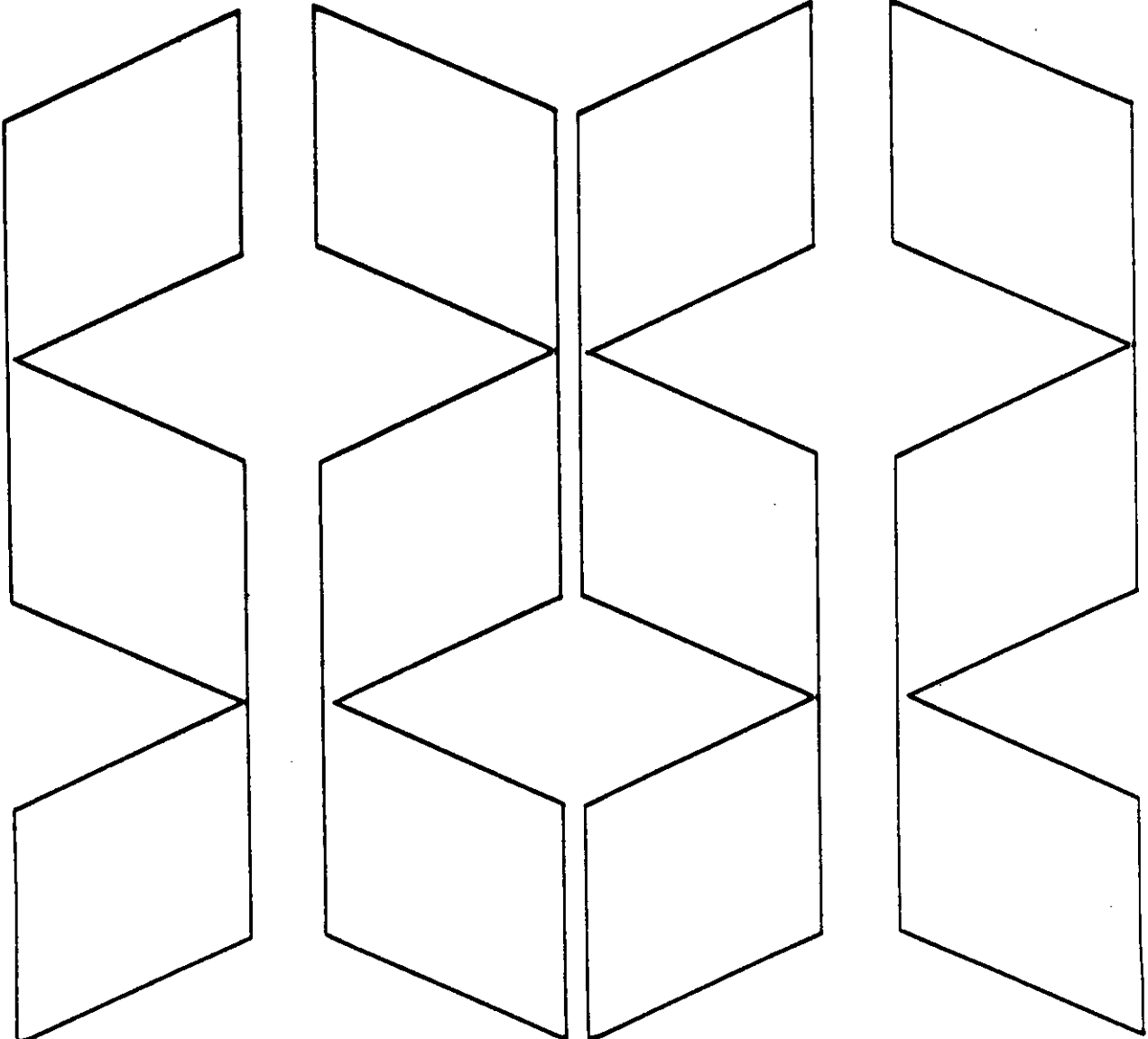

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# Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income

## 1989 Summary



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**DEFINITIONS**

**INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION:** Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equal the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

**INSHIPMENTS:** Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock brought in for immediate slaughter.

**MARKETINGS:** Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter, but live weight marketings (shown in pounds) excludes custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**FARM SLAUGHTER:** Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

**PRODUCTION:** Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, with an adjustment for any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

**PRICE:** State prices are as published in the February **AGRICULTURAL PRICES** report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

**CASH RECEIPTS:** Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

**VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION:** Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**GROSS INCOME:** Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

**MEAT ANIMALS**  
**Production, Disposition and Income**  
**1988-1989**

Total marketings of meat animals decreased slightly during 1989 as decreased cattle marketings were only partially offset by larger hog and sheep marketings. Higher prices were received for cattle and hogs while sheep prices declined resulting in total cash receipts increasing to \$46.6 billion, up 2 percent from 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1989 were: cattle and calves, 79 percent; hogs and pigs, 20 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs, and sheep were published in AGRICULTURAL PRICES, released February 28, 1990.

Production of meat animals during 1989 totaled 62.7 billion pounds, down fractionally from the 1988 production of 63.0 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$37.6 billion in 1989 compared with \$36.8 billion in 1988.

**CATTLE AND CALVES:** Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves increased during 1989, as higher prices more than offset a decrease in marketings. For 1989, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$36.7 billion compared with \$36.2 billion in 1988.

All cattle and calf marketings during 1989 totaled 52.4 billion pounds down 2 percent from 53.8 billion pounds in 1988. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$69.50 per 100 pounds live weight was up from the 1988 price of \$66.60. The calf price for 1989, at \$90.80, was up from the 1988 price of \$89.20.

**HOGS AND PIGS:** Cash receipts for hogs and pigs were \$9.43 billion during 1989, 2 percent above 1988. Marketings of 22.1 billion pounds during 1989 were 2 percent above 1988, while the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight increased slightly from \$42.30 in 1988 to \$42.50 in 1989.

**SHEEP AND LAMBS:** Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1989 totaled \$491 million, up 3 percent from 1988. The average price of sheep in 1989 was \$24.40 per 100 pounds of live weight, down from \$25.60 in 1988. Lamb prices decreased from \$69.10 in 1988 to \$66.10 in 1989.
