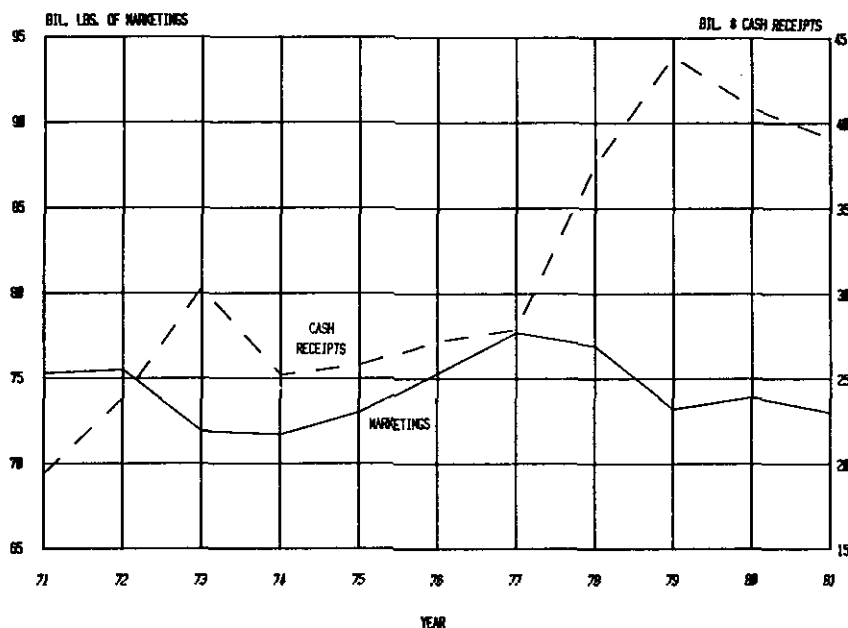

MEAT ANIMALS

Production, Disposition and Income
1980-81

Total marketings of meat animals decreased 1 percent during 1981. This, coupled with lower prices received for cattle and all sheep, resulted in cash receipts of \$39.1 billion, down 4 percent from 1980 and 11 percent below the record high of \$43.9 billion set in 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Both value of production and gross income were below the record highs set in 1979.

Cattle and calves contributed 74 percent of total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals in 1981 while hogs accounted for 25 percent and sheep and lambs 1 percent. For 1981, the U.S. prices received for cattle, sheep, and hogs were published in Agricultural Prices, released February 26, 1982.

Production of meat animals during 1981 totaled 63.4 billion pounds, down 1 percent from the 1980 production of 64.2 billion pounds. Marketings during 1981 increased for cattle and calves, and sheep and lambs but declined for hogs and pigs. Value of meat animal production was \$33.4 billion in 1981 compared with \$34.6 billion in 1980.

CATTLE AND CALVES: Cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves in 1981, at \$28.9 billion, were the third highest of record, exceeded by the \$34.4 billion in 1979 and \$31.5 billion in 1980. Higher cattle marketings during 1981 were offset by lower annual average prices for cattle and calves and resulted in the decline in cash receipts.

All cattle marketings during 1981 totaled 49.9 billion pounds, an increase of less than 1 percent from 1980 but down 15 percent from the record high of 58.5 billion pounds set in 1977. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$60.80 per 100 pounds live weight was down 3 percent from 1980. Calf prices for 1981, at \$64.00, were well below the \$76.80 in 1980.

HOGS AND PIGS: Cash receipts from marketings of hogs and pigs in 1981 were a record high \$9.80 billion, 10 percent above 1980, and 9 percent above the previous record high set in 1979.

Marketings, at 22.3 billion pounds, were down 5 percent from the record high of 1980. The declining marketings were offset by higher prices to provide the record cash receipts. The U.S. average price per 100 pounds live weight was \$43.90 in 1981, up from the \$38.00 in 1980.

SHEEP AND LAMBS: Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1981 totaled \$411 million, down 13 percent from 1980. The average price of sheep in 1981 was \$21.20 per 100 pounds live weight, nearly the same as 1980. Lamb prices fell \$8.70 to \$54.90 for 1981.

DEFINITIONS

INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION: Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equal the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

INSHIPMENTS: Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock for immediate slaughter.

MARKETINGS: Includes animals for slaughter market as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter but live weight marketings shown in pounds exclude custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

FARM SLAUGHTER: Animals slaughtered on farms. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

PRODUCTION: Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, and any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

PRICE: State prices are as published in the February Agricultural Prices report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers, by monthly quantities sold.

CASH RECEIPTS: Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION: Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.
