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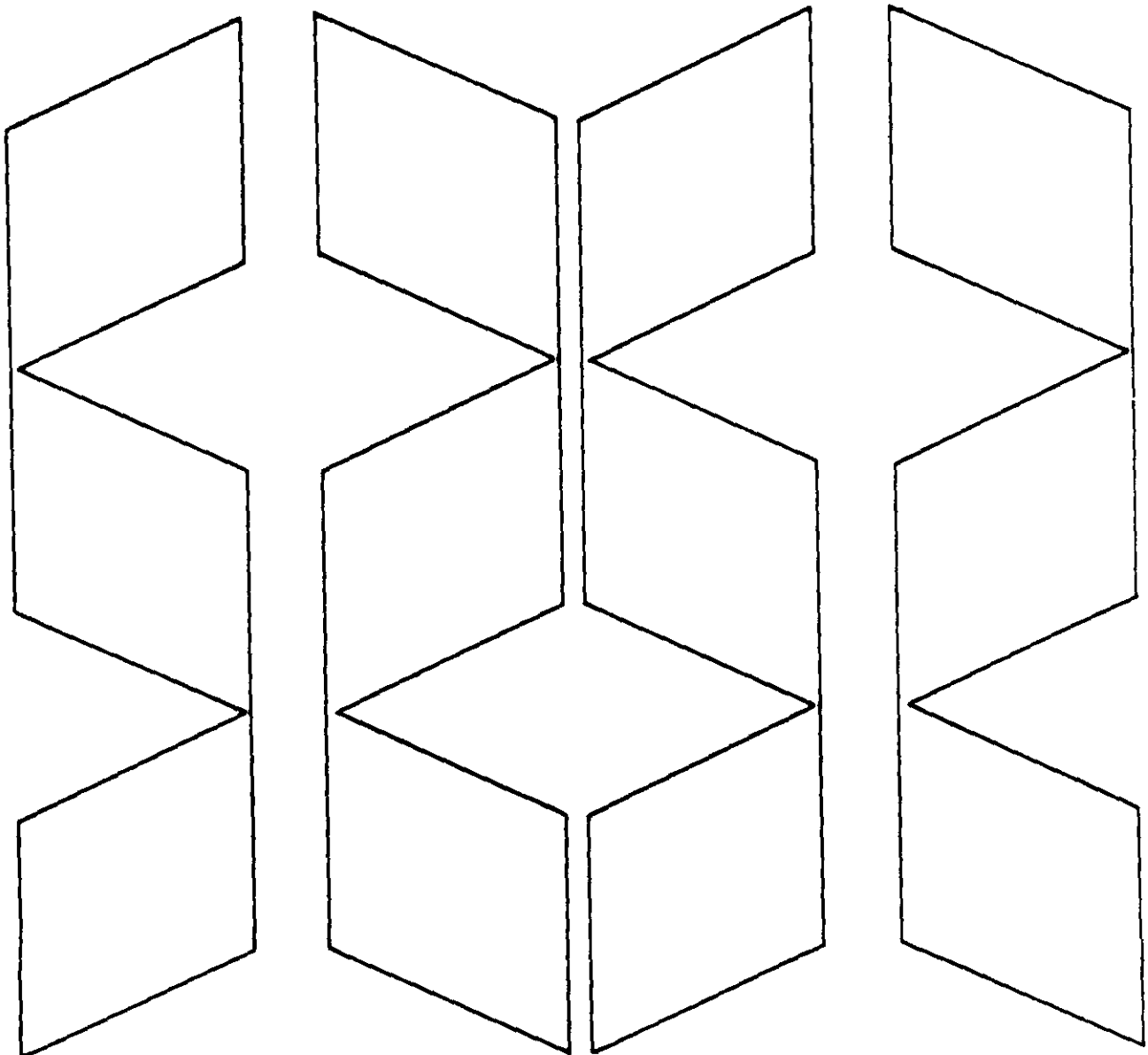
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# Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income

## 1986 Summary



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DEFINITIONS

**INVENTORY, SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION:** Balance sheet estimates; the sum of inventory on hand beginning of year, births and inshipments equals the sum of marketings, farm slaughter, deaths and inventory on hand end of year.

**INSHIPMENTS:** Livestock shipped into States for feeding or breeding. Excludes livestock for immediate slaughter.

**MARKETINGS:** Includes animals for slaughter market, as well as younger animals shipped to other States for feeding or breeding purposes. Excludes interfarm sales within the State and farm slaughter. Number of head marketed includes all custom slaughter but live weight marketings shown in pounds exclude custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**FARM SLAUGHTER:** Animals slaughtered on farms primarily for home consumption. Excludes custom slaughter for farmers at commercial establishments.

**PRODUCTION:** Includes total live weight of livestock marketed, farm slaughter and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced, minus live weight of inshipments, with an adjustment for any increase or decrease in live weight of inventory.

**PRICE:** State prices are as published in the February AGRICULTURAL PRICES report, and are computed by weighting monthly estimated prices received by farmers by monthly quantities sold.

**CASH RECEIPTS:** Receipts from marketings and any sale of farm slaughtered meats. Includes allowance for feeder pig outshipments.

**VALUE OF HOME CONSUMPTION:** Total value of slaughter on the farm and custom slaughter consumed on farms where produced.

**GROSS INCOME:** Sum of cash receipts and value of home consumption.

MEAT ANIMALS

Production, Disposition and Income  
1985-1986

Total marketings of meat animals increased slightly during 1986 as increased cattle marketings compensated for lower hog and sheep marketings. With higher prices received for hogs and sheep offsetting lower cattle prices, the resulting cash receipts of \$39.1 billion were up 1 percent from 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The percentage breakdown of contributions to total U.S. cash receipts from marketings of meat animals by species in 1986 were: cattle and calves, 74 percent; hogs and pigs, 25 percent; sheep and lambs, 1 percent. U.S. prices received for cattle, hogs and sheep were published in AGRICULTURAL PRICES, released February 27, 1987.

Production of meat animals during 1986 totaled 60.5 billion pounds, down 1 percent from the 1985 production of 61.0 billion pounds. The value of meat animal production was \$30.9 billion in 1986 compared with \$30.5 billion in 1985.

**CATTLE AND CALVES:** Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves declined slightly during 1986, as lower prices more than offset an increase in marketings. For 1986, cash receipts from the sale of cattle and calves totaled \$28.9 billion compared with \$29.1 billion in 1985.

All cattle and calf marketings during 1986 totaled 55.4 billion pounds, up 2 percent from the 54.5 billion pounds in 1985. The U.S. annual average price for cattle at \$52.60 per 100 pounds live weight was down 2 percent from 1985. The calf price for 1986, at \$61.10, was also down 2 percent.

**HOGS AND PIGS:** Cash receipts for hogs and pigs were \$9.70 billion during 1986, 7 percent above 1985. Marketings of 19.6 billion pounds during 1986 were 4 percent below 1985, while the U.S. annual average price per 100 pounds of live weight increased 12 percent from \$44.00 in 1985 to \$49.30 in 1986.

**SHEEP AND LAMBS:** Cash receipts from marketings of sheep and lambs in 1986 totaled \$484 million, down 4 percent from 1985. The average price of sheep in 1986 was \$25.60 per 100 pounds of live weight, up from \$23.90 in 1985. Lamb prices increased from \$67.70 in 1985 to \$69.00 in 1986.
