Rains over the last week have resulted in improved soil conditions. A near 10 percent decrease was reported in the drought areas scattered around the state this week. Moisture has slowed grain harvest however due to the rapid pace earlier both corn and bean harvest is still slightly ahead of the five year average. Winter wheat planting is currently on pace as well. The ever skyrocketing prices of fertilizer continue to be on the minds of producers. Reports of some trying to pre-buy ahead of more possible increases have be met with rejection as local retailers refuse to sell product they don't yet have for fears of not getting it or being upside down if they presale this early. Hay movement has been limited, as most have decent stockpiles. The supply of hay is moderate and demand is light to moderate and prices mostly steady.
