There is a lot of talk going on about pricing new crop hay given the extremely high grain cost and the increased price of inputs such as fuel and fertilizer this year. States to the west are already or perhaps more correctly remain in serious drought conditions which is driving up prices in those areas if any hay can even be found. Hay carry in the state is a mixed bag with some areas having some and other areas being void. The supply of hay is moderate, demand is light to moderate and prices are mostly steady although sales are very limited at this time.
