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PRODUCTION OF MANUFACTURED DAIRY PRODUCTS, 1973

Manufactured dairy products utilized 51 percent of the 1973 U. S. milk production, 1 percentage point less than the previous year. Manufacturing use, in whole milk equivalent based on milkfat content, was 58.7 billion pounds, down 6 percent from 1972.

BUTTER

Production of butter in the United States during 1973 totaled 919 million pounds, 17 percent below the previous year and the lowest annual production on record since the series started in 1919. Minnesota continued as the leading butter producing State with Wisconsin second.

CHEESE

Total cheese production, excluding cottage cheese, was at a record 2,685 million pounds and exceeded by 3 percent the previous high reported in 1972. Wisconsin accounted for 40 percent of the National total.

Production of American types of cheese totaled 1,672 million pounds, 2 percent more than in 1972 and a record high. American types (Cheddar, Colby, Washed curd, Stirred curd, Monterey and Jack) made up 62 percent of the Nation's cheese output. Cheddar at 1,308 million pounds, was up 1 percent from 1972. All other American types totaled 364 million pounds, an increase of 6 percent over the previous year. Wisconsin led in the production of American cheese and Minnesota ranked second.

Output of Italian types of cheese in 1973 set a record high of 565 million pounds, up 10 percent from 1972. Soft varieties of Italian cheese increased 14 percent over the previous year and accounted for 80 percent of the total production. Mozzarella and similar types accounted for most of the soft production. Total hard varieties decreased 1 percent from the previous year.

Production of Swiss cheese amounted to 164 million pounds, down 8 percent from 1972. Cream cheese production at 135 million pounds was 6 percent above 1972. Munster cheese at 46 million was about the same as last year while Brick cheese at 23 million pounds was 6 percent above the previous year. Blue cheese at 30 million pounds was 4 percent above 1972.

PROCESSED CHEESE

Production of processed cheese, cheese foods, spreads and cold pack totaled 1,162 million pounds, a 3 percent decrease from 1972. Processed cheese at 721 million pounds also showed a 3 percent decrease from the previous year. Processed cheese foods and spreads totaled 362 million pounds, and cold pack cheese and cheese foods production amounted to 79 million pounds.

COTTAGE CHEESE

Creamed cottage cheese production in 1973 was 958 million pounds, a decrease of 5 percent from 1972. Production of lowfat cottage cheese amounted to 128 million pounds, 25 percent above the previous year.

CONDENSED PRODUCTS

Production of canned evaporated and condensed whole milk amounted to 1,102 million pounds, down 7 percent from 1972. Bulk production of sweetened condensed whole milk totaled 77 million pounds, about the same as last year. Bulk production of unsweetened condensed whole milk at 159 million pounds was 9 percent below 1972.

Bulk production of sweetened condensed skim milk was 71 million pounds in 1973, up 18 percent from the previous year. Bulk output of unsweetened condensed skim milk was 808 million pounds, 10 percent below 1972.

Output of condensed whey during 1973 totaled 255 million pounds, 33 percent above the previous year.

DRY PRODUCTS

Total dry whey production set a new record high with 770 million pounds, 1 percent over 1972. Dry whey for human food amounted to 385 million pounds in 1973, a gain of 2 percent from the previous year. Dry whey for animal feed also at 385 million pounds was about the same as last year.

Production of nonfat dry milk for human food was 917 million pounds, a decrease of 25 percent from the previous year. Dry skim milk for animal feed at 10 million pounds showed a 24 percent decrease from 1972.

Dry whole milk production during 1973 was 78 million pounds, 4 percent above 1972.

Dry buttermilk production amounted to 43 million pounds, down 15 percent from 1972.

FROZEN PRODUCTS

Frozen dairy products (ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet, mellorine, and other products) totaled a record, 1,170 million gallons in 1973, an increase of 1 percent over 1972.

Total ice cream production in 1973 was 774 million gallons, up 1 percent from the previous year. Ice cream accounted for 66 percent of all frozen dairy products, about the same as in 1972. California again led in production of ice cream, followed by Pennsylvania.

Ice milk production in 1973 totaled a record high 292 million gallons, up 1 percent from 1972.

Production of milk sherbet amounted to 53 million gallons, 6 percent above 1972.

Mellorine in 1973 totaled 40.4 million gallons, a decrease of 11 percent from last year. Included are all frozen products made with fats and oils other than milkfat.

The output of ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet, and mellorine sold as soft products totaled 207 million gallons in 1973, about 18 percent of the total frozen products. Ice milk made up the major share of the soft-products total with 82 percent; ice cream, 12 percent; mellorine, 5 percent; and milk sherbet, 1 percent. Soft frozen dairy products are those sold from direct-serve soft freezer or milk shake machines.

WHOLE MILK USED

Whole milk used for cheese production, excluding creamed cottage cheese, amounted to 23.6 billion pounds, an increase of 4 percent over 1972 and accounted for 40 percent of all milk used for manufactured dairy products. This was the first year on record that milk used for cheese exceeded milk used for butter. American-type cheese used 16.8 billion pounds of whole milk, an increase of 3 percent over 1972. Other types of cheese used 6.8 billion pounds, up 6 percent from 1972. Evaporated and condensed whole milk required 2.4 billion pounds, bulk condensed milk products required 0.6 billion pounds, and dry whole milk 0.6 billion pounds.

Whole milk for butter production in 1973 was 16 percent below the previous year. A total of 20.7 billion pounds was used (excluding butter made from whey cream). Butter accounted for 35 percent of total whole milk for all products.

Frozen dairy products used 13.1 billion pounds of whole milk equivalent up 1 percent from 1972 and amounted to 22 percent of the total used for all products.
