**SHORN WOOL PRODUCTION** in the United States during 1990 was 88.3 million pounds, down 1 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Sheep and lambs shorn during 1990 totaled 11.2 million head, a decrease of 1 percent from 1989. Average fleece weight of shorn wool was 7.86 pounds per head, down 0.03 pounds from 1989. Total value of shorn wool was \$69.7 million, down 37 percent from \$111 million in 1989.

**MOHAIR PRODUCTION** in the five major producing States during 1990 was 16.3 million pounds, down 6 percent from 1989. Goats and kids clipped, at 2.17 million head, were down 12 percent from 1989. Average weight per head clipped was 7.5 pounds compared with 7.0 pounds a year earlier. Value of mohair production was \$15.1 million, down 44 percent from 1989.
