PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather for this week in South Georgia shows mild temps with daytime highs in the mid-70s to low 80s and evening lows in the 60s. The Central and Northern areas show daytime highs in the mid-70s with evening lows in the mid to high 40s. Possible rain and thunderstorms expected in the North part of the state for this Thursday.

The retail and holiday gift markets are about steady and demand remains strong while the commercial/domestic market has softened and prices are lower this week. Some growers are waiting to see if the market continues to drop and may hold their pecans in storage until it settles down. The export business for Asia has slowed down as the holiday for the Asia New Year is earlier this year and purchased deliveries should be on their way now or very soon. Deliveries of Blends (60-70 nut count) 43-47% meat yield sold in a range of about \$2.80-3.10 per point. Desirable Blends (60-70 nut count) 50-52% meat yield sold in a range of about \$3.50-3.60 per point.

Prices paid to growers (late afternoon October 31, 2019 through late afternoon November 5, 2019) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Cape Fear (deliveries very light) 50-52% meat yield 190-210

Desirables (deliveries light) 50-52% meat yield 220-235 mostly 220-225, yard tree lots 165-170

Elliott (deliveries very light) 52-53% meat yield 221-236, yard tree lots 150

Natives/Seedlings (deliveries light) yard tree lots 75-85

Moneymakers (deliveries very light) yard tree lots 60

Stuart (deliveries light) 47-48% meat yield 180-210, yard tree lots 100-125

LOUISIANA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Weather for this week shows mild temperatures and daytime highs in the 60s and 70s with evening lows in the 50s cooling down into the mid-30s by early next week. Possibility of thunderstorms and showers on November 7-8 in the southern areas of the state.

Prices paid to growers (from start of season thru late afternoon November 5, 2019) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Native/Seedlings (deliveries very light) yard tree lots 50 occasional higher

Elliott (deliveries very light) yard tree lots 100

Stuart (deliveries very light) yard tree lots 125
