PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather for this week has mild daytime temps cooling down to the mid 40s and warming back up to the high 60s for Thursday. Rain is expected in the Southern and Central areas for Wednesday, December 8.

Several lots were offered and many are small lots that indicate the growers are clearing out the orchards and making the last passes to collect any remaining pecans to be harvested. Most expect to finish up in about two weeks and many will plan for Holiday time this year. Prices are about steady and demand remains strong.

Deliveries of Blends (nut count 48-59) 47-57% meat yield sold in a range of about \$3.84-4.24 per point. Other Blends (nut count 60-65) sold in a range of about \$3.78-3.92 per point. The gift pack and candy businesses are still active while the export business is showing more interest. Online business is doing well for early gift buyers.
