Receipts: This Week: 13,140 Week Ago: 0 Year Ago: 11,946

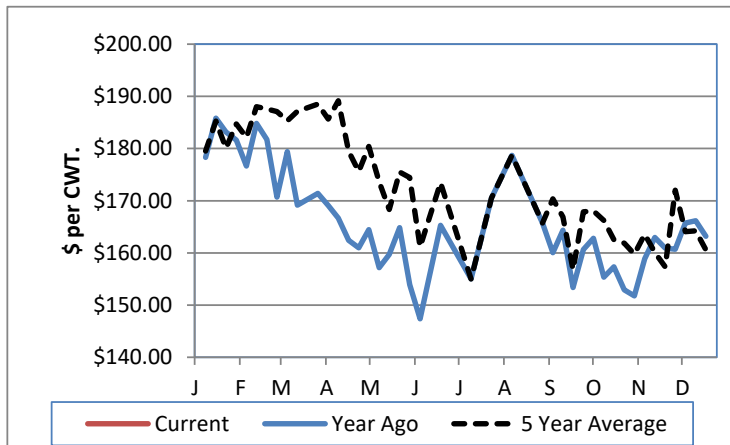
No market trend this week since the last sales were before Christmas of 2020. Demand was good for the large run of calves and feeder cattle and for the light supply of bred cows in the first full week of the New Year. Supply included: 83% Feeder Cattle (59% Steers, 41% Heifers, 0% Bulls); 7% Slaughter Cattle (93% Cows, 7% Bulls); 10% Replacement Cattle (38% Stock Cows, 25% Bred Cows, 37% Bred Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 47%. ** Next release of this report will be Tuesday, Jan 19 due to the Monday Holiday. **

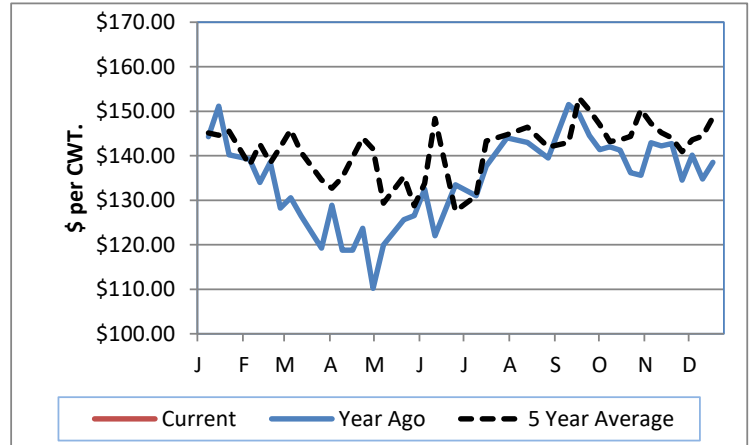
