Receipts: This Week: 4,683 Week Ago: 2,334 Year Ago: 3,987

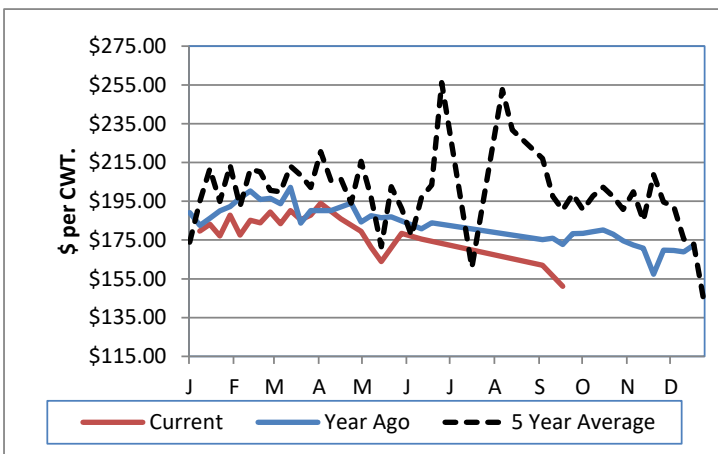
Compared to last week yearling steers and heifers sold steady to 6.00 higher, mostly 3.00-6.00 higher, calves sold with a higher undertone with light calves in high demand; slaughter and feeder cows 2.00-6.00 lower, slaughter bulls 2.00-4.00 lower. Nebraska feedlot trade slow to develop again this week. Limited trade reported through Thursday with the live sales at 102.00 and dressed 162.00. Elevator cash grain bids higher this week except soybeans lower. Winter wheat cash bids closed out the week .06-.09 higher, corn .02-.06 higher, soybeans .08-.16 lower, millet and sunflowers unchanged. **Note: The reporting period for the Wyoming Auction information in this report has changed from a Monday-Friday range to a Friday-Thursday period. The grain and hay information remains Monday-Friday.**

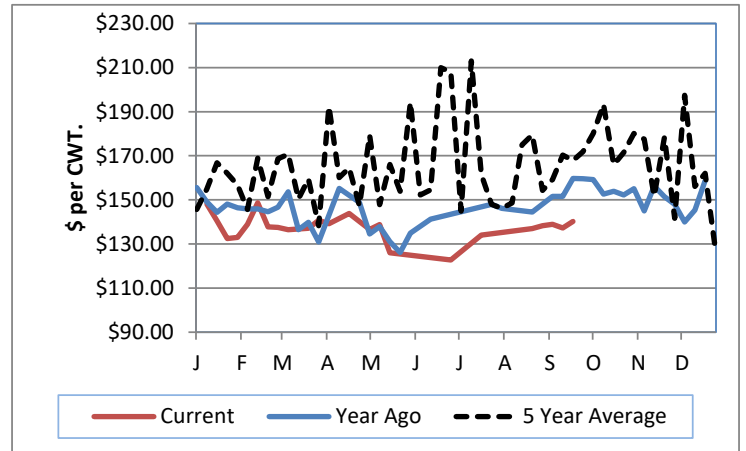
