Receipts: This Week: 4,881 Week Ago: 4,715 Year Ago: 4,180

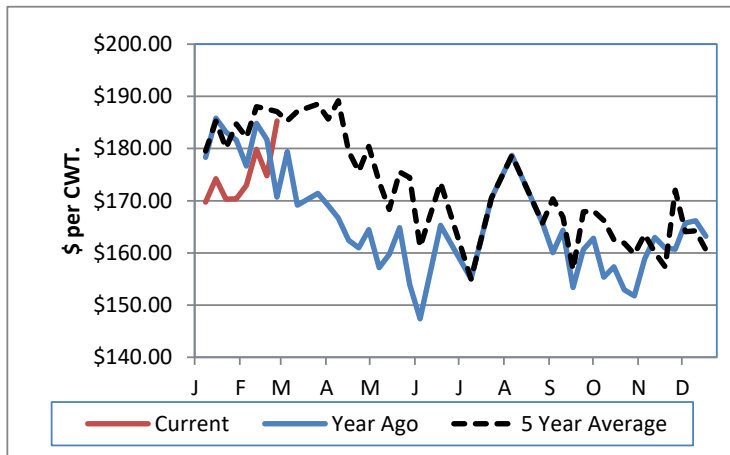

Fly weight heifers sold steady, 500 to 700 lbs sold 2.00 to 5.00 higher and over 700 lbs 1.00 to 2.00 higher. Slaughter cows sold 5.00 to 10.00 lower and slaughter bulls sold 10.00 lower. Demand was very good for cattle suited for summer grazing. With good demand for all other classes of feeders. Light to moderate demand for slaughter cattle. Good demand for heiferettes as some of these will become rebreeds and recipient cows.

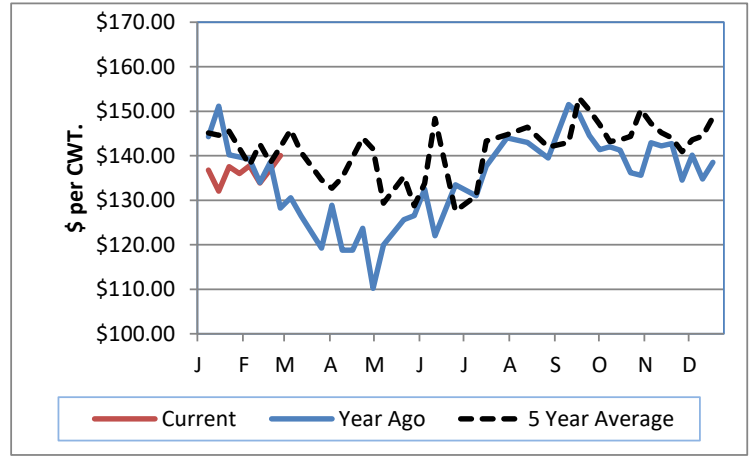
