Receipts: This Week: 6,999 Week Ago: 5,266 Year Ago: 4,110

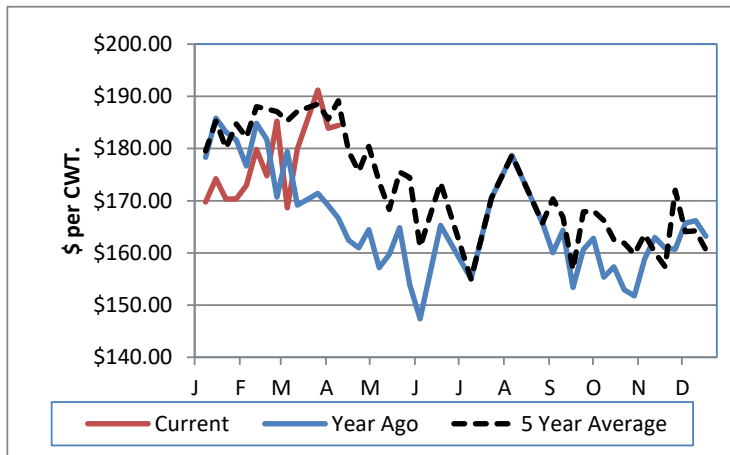

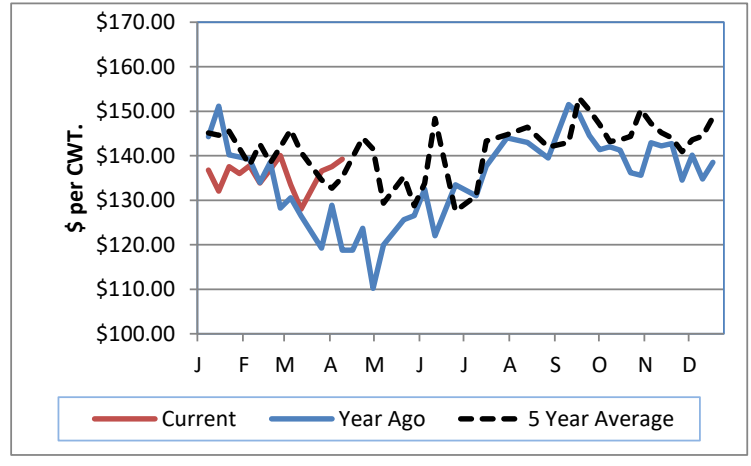
