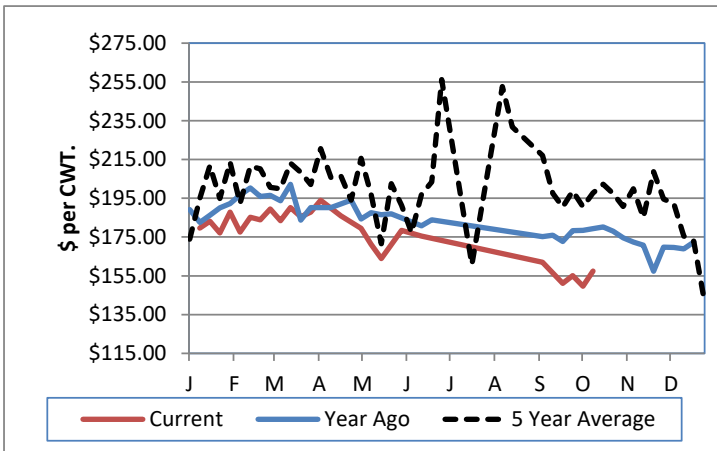
Compared to last week steers and heifers over 600 lbs sold mostly steady, instances 1.00-2.00 higher on 800-900 lb steers, steers under 600 lbs unevenly steady, heifers under 600 lbs 3.00-5.00 lower; slaughter and feeder cows steady to 1.00 higher, slaughter bulls steady to 2.00 higher. Demand good for many long strings of yearlings, light to moderate for calves. Nebraska feedlot trade higher this week. Live sales 1.50-2.00 higher at 109.00-111.00 and dressed 2.00 higher at 172.00. Elevator cash grain bids higher this week. Winter wheat cash bids closed out the week .07-.22 higher, corn .05-.18 higher, soybeans .20-.25 higher, millet unchanged and sunflowers unchanged to 25 higher. **Note: The reporting period for the Wyoming Auction information in this report has changed from a Monday-Friday range to a Friday-Thursday period. The grain and hay information remains Monday-Friday.**

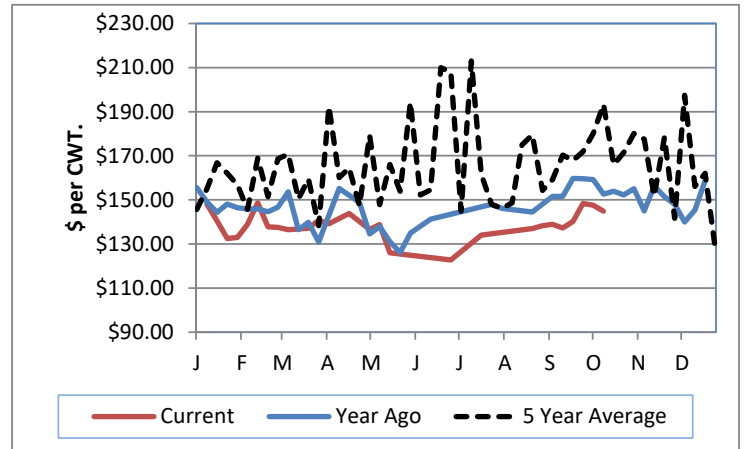
