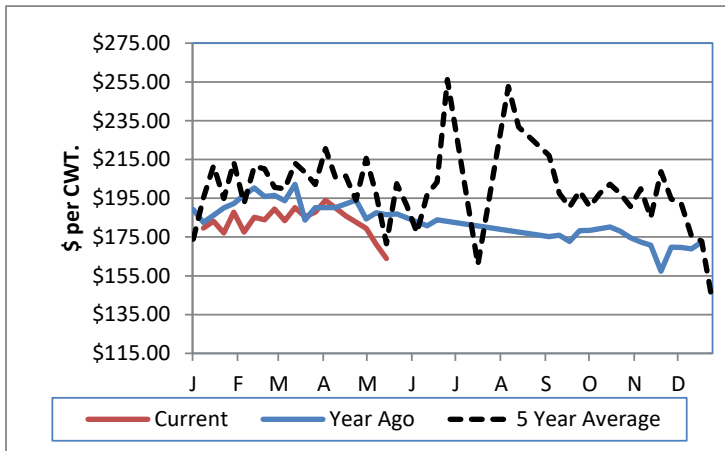
Compared to last week feeder steers and heifers not well tested slaughter cows steady, slaughter bulls steady to 3.00 lower, and feeder cows steady. Demand moderate to good. ***Torrington LS Wednesday feeder cattle sales will not be held again until August***. Bred cows pre-tested for age, pregnancy, bangs vaccination, mostly all in 3rd trimester, and all sold per head. Nebraska feedlot trade this week occurred mostly on Thursday with live sales dropping 3.00-4.00 lower at 117.00 and dressed sales 4.00-6.00 lower at 185.00-186.00. Elevator cash grain bids sharply higher than last week except millet lower. Winter wheat cash bids closed .33 higher, corn .28-.31 higher, soybeans .13 higher, millet 2.50 lower, and sunflowers unchanged.

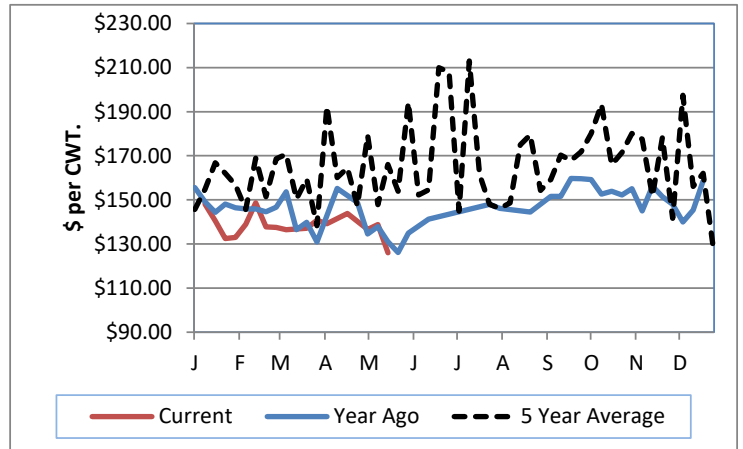
