APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): The hot, humid weather and occasional and isolated showers was interrupted on Tuesday with rains from Tropical storm Isias. The western swaths passed through quickly, but provided needed rain ranging from .5 to 4 inches depending on location in the District. Winds were minimal.

MICHIGAN: Trading is fairly active for light supplies of juice and sauce and peeler supplies. Prices for juice apples per cwt. are slightly higher and range from 11.00-13.00, mostly 11.00-12.00, picked up or delivered to receiving station. Prices for utilities range from 13.00-17.00 per cwt., while some preferred varieties range from 18.00-21.00, picked up or delivered. Prices include all available varieties from tree-run to packing shed eliminators. LAST REPORT FOR THE 2019 SEASON.
