Data Source: Uniform Price reports are created using information on the handling of milk obtained from Federal Milk Marketing Order personnel.

The Uniform Milk Price is the weighted average monthly Uniform Milk Price announced each month and represents the minimum milk price required to be paid by regulated handlers to producers pooled under the Federal Milk Marketing Order program. The Uniform Milk Price is the weighted average price of all producer milk used in all classes, sometimes referred to as the "Blend" Price.

The monthly Uniform Milk Price is derived by multiplying the minimum price for each class by the amounts of milk pooled in each class (this is the pool milk value for each class) and then dividing the aggregated combined pool milk value by the total amount of milk pooled each month.

The Uniform Butterfat Price is the weighted average of the monthly butterfat value. *The Uniform Butter Price is announced for the Appalachian (5), Florida (6), Southeast (7), and Arizona (131) Federal Milk Marketing Orders.* It represents the minimum butterfat price required to be paid by regulated handlers to producers for the butterfat pounds pooled under the Federal Milk Marketing Order program.

The Uniform Butterfat Price is derived by multiplying the monthly minimum class butterfat price for each class by the amounts of butterfat pooled in each class and then dividing the aggregated combined pool butterfat value by the total amount of butterfat pooled.

The Uniform Skim Milk Price is the weighted average monthly Uniform Skim Milk value and represents the minimum skim milk price required to be paid by regulated handlers to producers for the skim milk pooled under the Federal Milk Marketing Order program. *The Uniform Skim Milk Price is announced for the Appalachian (5), Florida (6), Southeast (7), and Arizona (131) Federal Milk Marketing Orders.*

The monthly Uniform Skim Milk Price is derived by multiplying the minimum class skim price for each class by the amounts of skim milk pooled in each class each month and then dividing the aggregated combined pool skim milk value by the total amount of skim milk pooled each month.

The Uniform Producer Milk Price Differential (PPD) is the value of the difference between the monthly Uniform Milk Price and the corresponding minimum monthly Class III Milk Price as announced. *The Uniform Producer Price Differential is announced for the Northeast (1), Upper Midwest (30), Central (32), Mideast (33), California (51), Pacific Northwest (124) and Southwest (126) Federal Milk Marketing Orders.*

Reliability: The AMS audit staff periodically perform on-site audits on the amounts of producer milk pooled to ensure accurate reporting of pool, utilization, and price information.
