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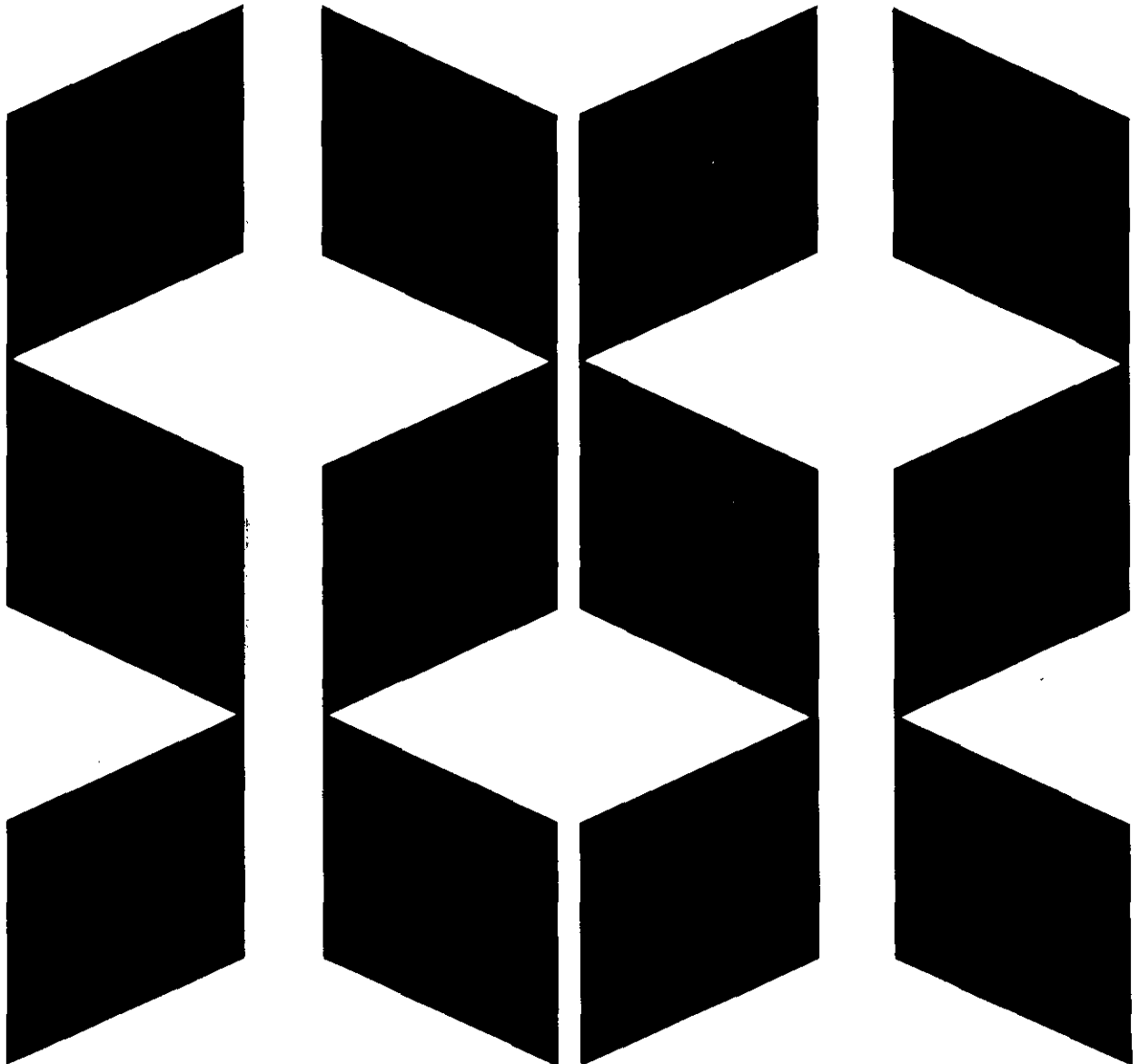

## POULTRY

### PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, GROSS INCOME AND VALUE, BY STATES, 1982-83

#### GROSS INCOME AND VALUE OF PRODUCTION UP 4 PERCENT

The combined value of production from broilers, eggs and turkeys and gross income from chickens in 1983 was \$9.75 billion, up 4 percent from the \$9.33 billion in 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the combined 1983 total, 50 percent came from broilers, 36 percent from eggs, 13 percent from turkeys and 1 percent from other chickens.

#### VALUE OF BROILERS PRODUCTION UP 8 PERCENT

The value of production for broilers, a record high of \$4.87 billion, was up 8 percent from the \$4.51 billion in 1982 and 4 percent above 1981. Total number of broilers produced in 1983 was 4.18 billion birds, up 1 percent from 1982. Prices in 1983 averaged 28.6 cents per pound on a live weight equivalent basis, compared with 26.9 cents per pound in 1982 and 28.5 in 1981.

In 19 selected States, which produced 96 percent of the Nation's broilers, production was 4.04 billion birds during the marketing year December 1, 1982 - November 30, 1983, up 1 percent from the 4.00 billion produced the previous year. Value of production, at \$4.70 billion, was up 8 percent from the \$4.34 billion in 1982. The 19 States produced 16.4 billion pounds (7.45 million metric tons) of broilers in 1983, compared with 16.2 billion pounds (7.33 million metric tons) a year earlier.

#### VALUE OF EGG PRODUCTION UP FRACTIONALLY

Value of egg production was \$3.46 billion, up fractionally from 1982. Number of eggs sold totaled 67.7 billion, down 2 percent from the 69.3 billion a year earlier. In 1983, eggs averaged 61.1 cents per dozen, compared with 59.5 cents in 1982.

#### INCOME FROM OTHER CHICKENS UP 23 PERCENT

Gross income from chickens raised (excluding broilers) was \$152 million, up 23 percent from the \$123 million a year ago. Prices in 1983 averaged 12.7 cents per pound live weight, compared with 10.3 cents in 1982. Chickens raised in 1983 (excluding broilers) totaled 272 million birds, down 3 percent from 1982.

#### HOME CONSUMPTION OF EGGS AND CHICKENS DOWN

Egg consumption on production units in 1983 at 423 million, was 2 percent below the previous year. The number of chickens consumed on production units, totaled 9.35 million, compared with 10.2 million a year ago.

#### VALUE OF TURKEY PRODUCTION UP 1 PERCENT

Value of production from turkeys was \$1.26 billion for 1983, one percent above the \$1.25 billion for 1982. Turkey production in 1983 totaled 3.32 billion pounds (1.50 million metric tons) live weight, 5 percent above the 1982 production. The price received by producers during 1983 averaged 38.0 cents per pound (live weight equivalent), compared with 39.5 cents a year ago.

Death loss rate of young turkeys during 1983 was 9.0 percent, up from the 8.5 percent in 1982. Breeder hen mortality rate of 5.9 percent was 0.8 percentage points above both the 1982 and 1981 rates.
