PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, GROSS INCOME AND VALUE, BY STATES, 1981-82

GROSS INCOME AND VALUE OF PRODUCTION DOWN 4 PERCENT

The combined value of production from broilers, eggs and turkeys and gross income from chickens in 1982 was \$9.34 billion, down 4 percent from the \$9.75 billion in 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the combined 1982 total, 48 percent came from broilers, 37 percent from eggs, 14 percent from turkeys and 1 percent from other chickens.

VALUE OF BROILERS PRODUCTION DOWN 4 PERCENT

The value of production for broilers was \$4.51 billion, down 4 percent from the 1981 record high of \$4.70 billion. Total number of broilers produced in 1982 was 4.15 billion birds, virtually the same as 1981. Prices in 1982 averaged 26.9 cents per pound on a live weight equivalent basis, compared with 28.5 cents per pound in 1981.

In 19 selected States, which produced 96 percent of the Nation's broilers, production was 4.00 billion birds during the marketing year December 1, 1981 - November 30, 1982, up 1 percent from the 3.98 billion produced the previous year. Value of production, at \$4.34 billion, was down 4 percent from the \$4.50 billion in 1981. The 19 States produced 16.2 billion pounds (7.33 million metric tons) of broilers in 1982, compared with 15.8 billion pounds (7.18 million metric tons) a year earlier.

VALUE OF EGG PRODUCTION DOWN 6 PERCENT

Value of egg production was \$3.46 billion, down 6 percent from 1981. Number of eggs sold totaled 69.2 billion, down 137 million from the previous year. In 1982, eggs averaged 59.5 cents per dozen, 3.6 cents less than in 1981.

INCOME FROM OTHER CHICKENS LOWER

Gross income from chickens raised (excluding broilers) was \$123 million, compared with \$134 million a year ago. Prices in 1982 averaged 10.3 cents per pound live weight, compared with 11.1 cents in 1981. Chickens raised in 1982 (excluding broilers) totaled 281 million birds, down 1.29 million from 1981.

HOME CONSUMPTION OF EGGS AND CHICKENS DECLINE

The number of chickens consumed on production units in 1982 totaled 10.2 million, compared with 10.6 million in 1981. Egg consumption at 434 million was 2 percent below the previous year.

VALUE OF TURKEY PRODUCTION UP FRACTIONALLY

Value of production from turkeys was about \$1.25 billion, for both 1982 and 1981. Turkey production in 1982 totaled 3.18 billion pounds (1.44 million metric tons) live weight, 3 percent below the 1981 production. The price received by producers during 1982 averaged 39.5 cents per pound (live weight equivalent), compared with 38.2 cents a year ago.

Death loss rate of young turkeys during 1982 was 8.5 percent, down from the 8.8 percent in 1981. Breeder hen mortality rate of 5.1 percent was unchanged from 1981 and was 1.3 percentage points below the 1980 rate.
