POULTRY

Production, Disposition, and Gross Income, 1980-81, by States

GROSS INCOME UP 9 PERCENT

The combined gross income from eggs, broilers, chickens, and turkeys in 1981 was \$9.74 billion, up 9 percent from the \$8.97 billion in 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

BROILER, CHICKEN, AND EGG INCOME UP

Gross income from the production of broilers, chickens, and eggs in the year ending November 30, 1981 totaled \$8.50 billion compared with \$7.70 billion the previous year. Of the 1981 gross income, 55 percent was from broilers, about 43 percent from eggs and 2 percent from other chickens.

Gross income for all broilers, a record high of \$4.70 billion, was up 9 percent from 1980. Total number of broilers produced in 1981 was 4.15 billion birds, up 5 percent from 1980. Prices in 1981 averaged 28.5 cents per pound on a live weight equivalent basis, compared with 27.7 cents per pound in 1980.

In the 19 selected States, which produced 96 percent of the Nation's broilers, production was 3.98 billion birds during the marketing year December 1, 1980 - November 30, 1981, up 5 percent from the 3.77 billion produced the previous year. Gross income from broiler production was \$4.50 billion, 10 percent above the \$4.09 billion grossed in 1980. The 19 States produced 15.8 billion pounds (7.18 million metric tons) of broilers in 1981, compared with 14.8 billion pounds (6.70 million metric tons) a year earlier.

Gross income from eggs was \$3.66 billion, up 12 percent from 1980. Number of eggs sold totaled 69.2 billion, about the same as a year ago. In 1981 eggs averaged 63.1 cents per dozen, 6.8 cents more than in 1980.

Gross income from chickens raised (excluding broilers) was \$137 million, compared with \$133 million a year ago. Prices in 1981 averaged 11.1 cents per pound live weight, compared with 11.0 cents in 1980. Chickens raised in 1981 (excluding broilers) totaled 281 million birds, down 2 percent from 1980.

HOME CONSUMPTION OF EGGS AND CHICKENS DECLINES

The number of chickens consumed on Production Units in 1981 totaled 10.9 million, compared with 11.1 million in 1980. Egg consumption at 444 million was 2 percent below the previous year.

INCOME FROM TURKEYS DOWN

Gross income from turkeys in 1981 was \$1.25 billion, compared with \$1.27 billion in 1980. Turkey production in 1981 totaled 3.26 billion pounds (1.48 million metric tons) live weight, 6 percent more than the 1980 production. The price received by producers during 1981 averaged 38.2 cents per pound (live weight equivalent), compared with 41.3 cents a year ago.

Death Loss of young turkeys during 1981 was 8.8 percent, down from the 9.4 percent in 1980, but unchanged from the 1979 mortality rate. Breeder hen mortality at 5.1 percent declined from the 6.4 percent in 1980 and is 0.2 of a percentage point below the 1979 rate.
