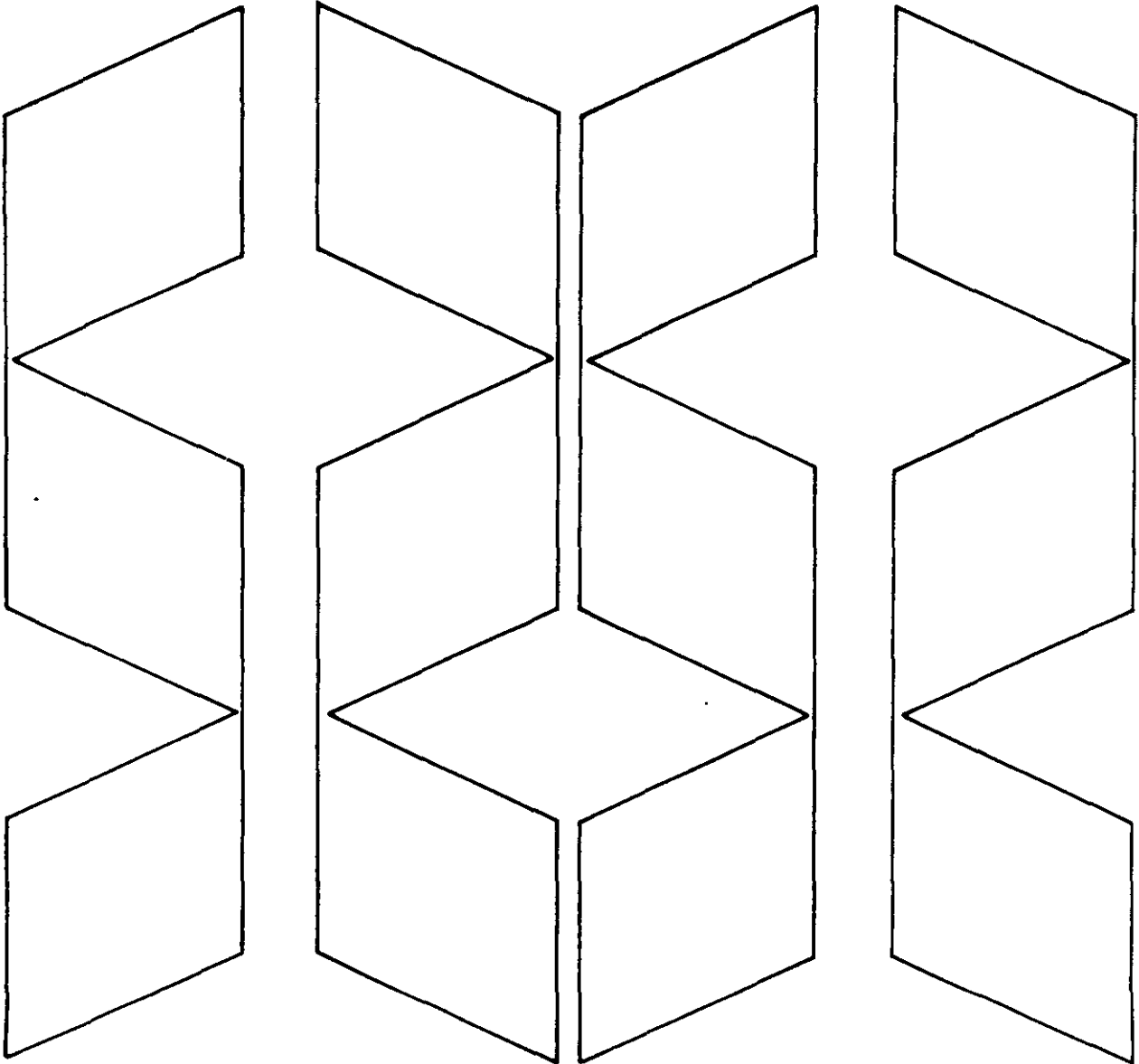

PRODUCTION, DISPOSITION, GROSS INCOME AND VALUE, BY STATES, 1983-84

GROSS INCOME AND VALUE OF PRODUCTION UP 22 PERCENT

The combined value of production from broilers, eggs and turkeys, and gross income from chickens in 1984 was \$12.0 billion, up 22 percent from the \$9.76 billion in 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the combined 1984 total, 51 percent came from broilers, 34 percent from eggs, 14 percent from turkeys and 1 percent from other chickens.

VALUE OF BROILERS PRODUCTION UP 23 PERCENT

The value of production for broilers, a record high of \$6.01 billion, was up 23 percent from the \$4.87 billion in 1983. Total number of broilers produced in 1984 was 4.28 billion birds, up 2 percent from 1983. Pounds produced totaled 17.9 billion pounds (8.10 million metric tons) compared with 17.0 billion pounds (7.73 million metric tons) a year earlier. Prices in 1984 averaged 33.7 cents per pound on a live weight equivalent basis, compared with 28.6 cents per pound in 1983.

VALUE OF EGG PRODUCTION UP 18 PERCENT

Value of egg production was \$4.11 billion, up 18 percent from 1983. Number of eggs sold totaled 67.8 billion, virtually the same as a year earlier. In 1984, eggs averaged 72.3 cents per dozen, compared with 61.1 cents in 1983.

INCOME FROM OTHER CHICKENS UP 16 PERCENT

Gross income from chickens raised (excluding broilers) was \$176 million, up 16 percent from the \$152 million a year ago. Prices in 1984 averaged 15.9 cents per pound live weight, compared with 12.7 cents in 1983. Chickens raised in 1984 (excluding broilers) totaled 290 million birds, up 6 percent from the 273 million in 1983.

VALUE OF TURKEY PRODUCTION UP 30 PERCENT

Value of production from turkeys was \$1.66 billion for 1984, 30 percent above the \$1.27 billion for 1983. Turkey production in 1984 totaled 3.39 billion pounds (1.54 million metric tons) live weight, 2 percent above the 1983 production. The price received by producers during 1984 averaged 48.9 cents per pound (live weight equivalent), compared with 38.0 cents a year ago.

Death loss of young turkeys during 1984 was 8.8 percent, down from the 9.0 percent in 1983. Breeder hen mortality rate at 6.1 percent, was 0.2 of a percentage point above 1983 and 1.0 point above 1982.
