So far for Monday negotiated cash trading has been at a standstill in the Southern Plains and Nebraska. In the Western Cornbelt negotiated cash trading has been inactive on very light demand. Not enough trades for a market trend. Last week in the Southern Plains live cash trades moved at 125.00. For the prior week in Nebraska live cash trades moved mostly from 125.00-125.50 and dressed cash trades moved at 200.00. For previous week in the Western Cornbelt live cash trades moved mostly from 124.50-126.00 and dressed cash trades moved at 200.00.
