Farm Numbers Drop 28 Percent During Past Decade

The Nation had an estimated 2,971,000 operating farms during 1969,3 percent less than in 1968. The preliminary estimate for 1970 indicates 2,895,000 farms will be in operation, another 3 percent drop.

'Total land in farms, estimated at about 1,124 million acres for 1969, continues a slow steady decline but at a slower rate than the farm numbers. For 1970, the preliminary estimate of land in farms is 1,119 million acres.

The past decade saw a 28 percent decline in number of farms while only a 5 percent drop was recorded in land in farms. These changes are associated with a 31 percent increase in the average size of farms. The continued disappearance of the small marginal farms along with larger unit mergers into more efficient operations contribute most to the change in farm numbers. Urbanization and highway construction lead the reasons for decline in land in farms. These are partially offset by new lands being brought into production.
