## CITRUS FRUITS

Revised Estimates, by States, 1969-70 through 1974-75

Production - Use - Value

This report presents estimates, by States, of the production, use, value, and utilization of citrus fruits for the crop seasons 1969-70 through 1974-75. These estimates have been revised where necessary by reviewing marketing agreement records, recorded truck and rail movement, quantities inspected, quantities used by processors, and the 1974 Census of Agriculture.

### Historical Series

Historical series for States and the United States were published in "Citrus Fruits, Production, Use, and Value, by States, 1909-10 through 1964-65," Statistical Bulletin No. 380, issued January 1967, and "Citrus Fruits Revised Estimates, by States, 1964-65 through 1969-70," Statistical Bulletin No. 493, issued September 1972.

### Crop Seasons

Orange and grapefruit trees generally bloom in late winter and early spring, and fruit is picked 8 to 18 months after blooming. Harvest extends from the fall of the year of bloom to the fall of the following year. Harvest of early and midseason oranges, including navels, starts in the early fall and continues until spring. Harvest of Valencia oranges in Florida, Texas, and Arizona extends from about the first of February to early summer. In northern California, Valencia harvest starts in March and is usually completed by early summer. In southern California, harvest generally starts about May 1 of the year after bloom and extends into December.

Grapefruit harvest, except for the California summer crop, begins in the fall in all States and ends by early summer of the next year. California summer grapefruit are marketed mostly from early summer through September of the year after bloom.

California lemons, which make up the major part of the Nation's lemon production, are harvested in all months of the year. The crop year in this publication is considered to be from August 1 to July 31.

Nearly all U. S. limes are grown in Florida and are picked mostly from April through December.

The values shown in this report relate to the crop seasons and should not be confused with estimates of calendar-year cash income.
