### National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending firm on all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are close balanced to tight and held with confidence. Retail and food service demand is moderate to good. Processing schedules are normal to instances reduced with many plants running lighter schedules next week for Thanksgiving Day. Floor stocks are balanced. Market activity is moderate to active. In the parts structure, prices are firm for tenders and jumbo boneless skinless breasts, at least steady for wings, and mostly steady for the remaining items. Offerings of wings and white meat items are in good balance to short and dark meat is available. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate to heavy. Weights are mixed but reported as mostly desirable.

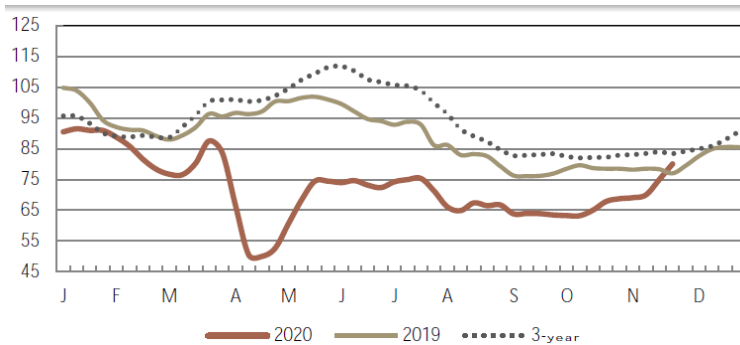

Supplies are moderate to heavy for current needs as dealers work around typical challenges associated with the Thanksgiving holiday next week. The 2021 contract season is progressing slowly as buyers and sellers continue with negotiations. Processing schedules are normal. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are light to moderate. Frame prices are steady to firm with trading levels at 9-12 cents FOB., mostly 10-11 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Down 2 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 232 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 14, 2020, down 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.2 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down 2 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 180 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 14, 2020, down 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 4, 2020 through November 14, 2020 for the United States were 8.49 billion. Cumulative placements were down 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
