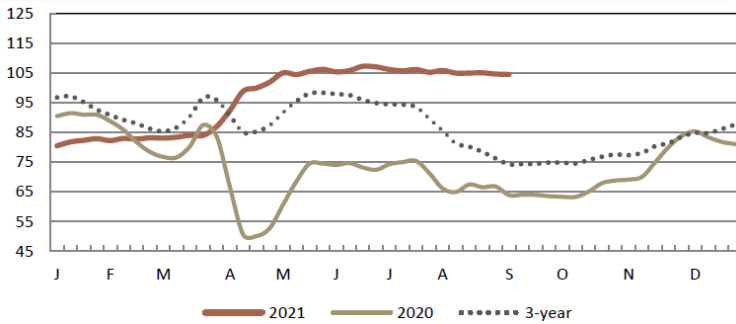
Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are moderate for current trade needs. Retail and foodservice demand is mostly moderate for the approaching weekend. Floor stocks are adequate. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices for wings and bone-in breasts are steady to weak. Tenders and boneless skinless breasts range steady to mostly firm, and all other parts are steady. Offerings of tenders and boneless skinless breasts continue to clear satisfactorily. Bone-in breasts and wings are moderate to heavy, with smaller size wings slightly more available. Dark meat items are light to moderate, and the balance of parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but mostly desirable.

Supplies are moderate as preparations begins for the upcoming holiday weekend. Processing schedules are normal to less than normal due to some operations being hampered by labor issues. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady with trading levels unchanged at 10-12 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 3 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 238 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 21, 2021, up 3 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.6 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 21, 2021, up 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through August 21, 2021 for the United States were 6.17 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 02-Oct-21 is estimated at 162.6 million head. This compares to 162.1 million head the previous week and to 170.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 173.1 million head and the national weighted average price was 66.73 cents per pound.
