National Broiler Market-At-A-Glance


Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to weak with heavier sizes continuing in the weakest position. Offerings are fully adequate. Retail and food service demand is is light to moderate. Floor stocks are sufficient. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, tenderloins are steady, wings steady at best with some finding smaller sized product in a better position, boneless skinless and bone-in breasts steady to weak. The market on dark meat is steady to weak while bone-in dark items are steady to firm. Supplies of leg quarters, drums and thighs continue in the best position; boneless skinless breast are available, and tenders and wings moderate to heavy for current needs. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mostly desirable weights.

Broiler Hatchery

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 233 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 6, 2019, up 1 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.9 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending July 6, 2019, up slightly from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through July 6, 2019 for the United States were 5.03 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 10-Aug-19 is estimated at 168.2 million head. This compares to 171.5 million head the previous week and to 167.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 146.2 million head and the national weighted average price was 114.31 cents per pound.
