National Broiler Market-At-A-Glance


Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to weak with 3lb and up sizes remaining in the weakest position. Offerings are light to moderate. Retail demand light to moderate; improvement is noted for the weekend and for early next week arrivals due to the up-coming holiday. Foodservice demand light to moderate. Floor stocks are sufficient for current needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, dark meat items are steady to firm and white items are mixed. Supplies of dark meat items are moving well; bone in breast which are popular for the holiday are light and wings are moderate to heavy. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mostly desirable weights.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up Slightly

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 232 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 22, 2019, up slightly from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.8 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 190 million chicks for meat production during the week ending June 22, 2019, up 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through June 22, 2019 for the United States were 4.65 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 03-Aug-19 is estimated at 171.5 million head. This compares to 168.2 million head the previous week and to 167.2 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 174.0 million head and the national weighted average price was 116.34 cents per pound.
