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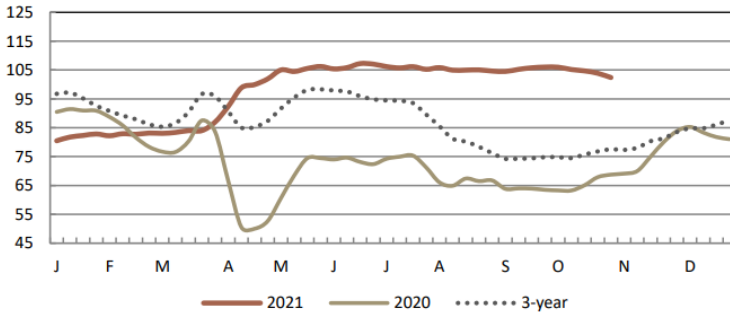
Livestock, Poultry & Grain Market News

[National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance](#)

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending weak for three pound and heavier sizes; steady to weak for the smaller sizes. Offerings of all sizes are readily available and slow to clear with labor issues reported. Retail and foodservice demand are light to instances moderate entering the weekend. Floor stocks are closely balanced. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, prices are steady to weak for boneless skinless breasts, dark meat cuts, wings, and tenders. Offerings of wings, boneless skinless breasts, and dark meat cuts are moderate to heavy with thigh meat, leg quarters, and jumbo boneless skinless breasts in the longest position. Tenders are available and competitively priced. The remainder of parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are noted as moderate to heavy.

Prices of 15-20% MSC are trending steady to weak. Domestic and export demand continues to be reported as light with buyer interest unaggressive. Supplies are moderate. The initial phase of the 2022 contract season is underway with nothing to report during this time. Processing schedules varied as processors continue to contend with processor labor issues. Market activity is slow. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady with trading levels unchanged at 10-12.50 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 228 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 16, 2021, up 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.2 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 181 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 16, 2021, up 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through October 16, 2021 for the United States were 7.62 billion. Cumulative placements were up slightly from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 27-Nov-21 is estimated at 156.8 million head. This compares to 156.1 million head the previous week and to 167.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 170.5 million head and the national weighted average price was 67.87 cents per pound.
