National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices remain steady to weak entering the weekend. Offerings of all sizes are ranging from light to readily available. Demand into retail and food service channels is mostly light to moderate. Floor stocks are in balance. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, white meat items and dark items remain steady to weak, while wings are in a good position aided by increased interest due to upcoming football season. Supplies of wings are light to moderate. The balance of white meat and dark items are moderate to sometimes heavy. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are mostly desirable weights.

Prices of 15-20% MSC are mostly steady. Domestic spot market demand is light to moderate as processors have covered most of their Labor Day needs. Export demand is light to moderate. Supplies are usually moderate. Preparation begins for the upcoming extended Holiday weekend with some working out front to circumvent those typical challenges it will create. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to available. Frame prices are trading at 7-10 cents FOB, mostly 7-8 cents FOB.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 3 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 232 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 17, 2019, up 3 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.8 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 189 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 17, 2019, up 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through August 17, 2019 for the United States were 6.16 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 28-Sep-19 is estimated at 166.6 million head. This compares to 166.3 million head the previous week and to 168.3 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 168.6 million head and the national weighted average price was 82.52 cents per pound.
