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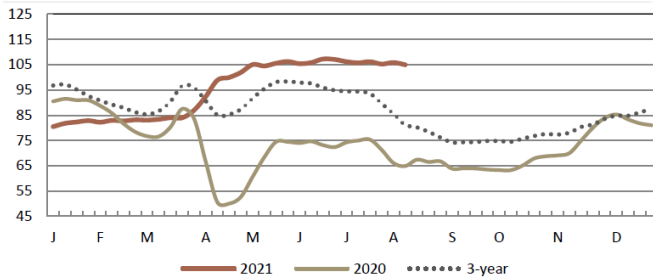

## National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices are generally trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are mostly moderate for the approaching weekend. Retail and foodservice demand are moderate for current need. Floor stocks are sufficient. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices are steady to firm for tenders, steady to weak for dark meat items. Wings, boneless skinless breasts, and the remainder of parts are steady. Offerings of wings and dark meat items are moderate to heavy, with slight premiums noted on leg quarters. Tenders are light and clearing satisfactorily. Bone-in breasts are available, and the balance of parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but mostly desirable.

Export and domestic demand is light to moderate and continue to be generally unaggressive. Supplies are moderate for both fresh and frozen MSC. Processing schedules are mostly normal. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady to slightly lower with trading levels at 9.5-12 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 6 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 241 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 24, 2021, up 6 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 80.1 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down 1 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending July 24, 2021, down 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through July 24, 2021 for the United States were 5.42 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 04-Sep-21 is estimated at 163.1 million head. This compares to 162.7 million head the previous week and to 168.1 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 166.0 million head and the national weighted average price was 66.10 cents per pound.
