### National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

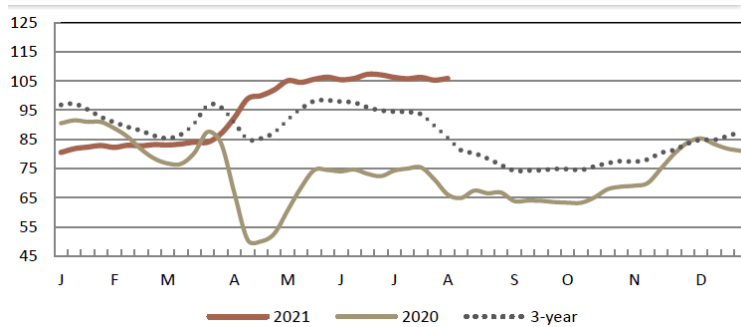
Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are light to moderate for current needs. Retail and foodservice demand is light to moderate for the upcoming weekend. Floor stocks are adequate. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices are steady to firm for tenders and dark meat items. Wings and boneless skinless breasts are steady to weak, bone-in breasts remain weak, and all other parts are steady. Offerings of tenders and dark meat cuts are light to moderate, with leg quarters slow to clear. Wings and boneless skinless breasts are moderate to heavy, with smaller size wings and jumbo size breasts in the longest position. Bone-in breasts are available. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but mostly desirable.

Prices of 15-20% MSC are trending steady to slightly lower for frozen, steady to weak for fresh with a steady to weak undertone. Spot market demand into domestic and export channels range light to moderate and continue to be unaggressive. Supplies are moderate for both fresh and frozen MSC. Processing schedules are mostly normal. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady with trading at 10-15 cents FOB, mostly 10-12 FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 237 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 17, 2021, up 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 80.1 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down 2 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending July 17, 2021, down 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through July 17, 2021 for the United States were 5.24 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 28-Aug-21 is estimated at 162.7 million head. This compares to 162.6 million head the previous week and to 165.6 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 164.1 million head and the national weighted average price was 71.25 cents per pound.
