National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance


Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to weak for all sizes. Movement on ready to cook whole birds slightly improved due to holiday weekend demand. Offerings are moderate to heavy for current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is mostly moderate. Buyers are monitoring market conditions in anticipation of Hurricane Dorian making landfall in the Florida area this weekend and purchasing product as needed. Floor stocks are adequate to sometimes heavier than desired. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, white meat and dark meat items are moderate to heavy, with wings and tenders mostly moderate. Wings are in good balance, but all other parts range moderate to heavy with thighs and drums moving slow. Typical transportation challenges associated with a major holiday weekend are reported, while also being watchful of Hurricane Dorian. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are mostly desirable weights.

Processing schedules are varied as we enter the extended Labor Day weekend. Market activity is slow to instances moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to available. Frame prices are trading at 6.5-9 cents FOB, mostly 6.5-8 cents FOB.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 3 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 232 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 24, 2019, up 3 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.8 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 189 million chicks for meat production during the week ending August 24, 2019, up 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through August 24, 2019 for the United States were 6.35 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

This compares to 166.6 million head the previous week and to 168.3 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 173.1 million head and the national weighted average price was 82.57 cents per pound.
