



# BROILER MARKET NEWS REPORT

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Livestock, Poultry & Grain Market News

[National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance](#)

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending fully steady to firm for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are light to moderate, with four pounds and lighter sizes in the better position. Retail and food service demand is moderate to good in the Eastern region, light to moderate in all other regions. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Floor stocks are adequate. Market activity is mostly moderate. In the parts structure, prices are trending firm for wings, steady to firm for bone-in breasts, and weak for tenders. Dark meat items, boneless skinless breasts, and the remainder of parts are steady. Supplies of wings are in close balance to tight, with some premiums noted. Tenders continue heavy and discounted, and all other parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate to heavy. Weights are mixed from desirable to heavy.

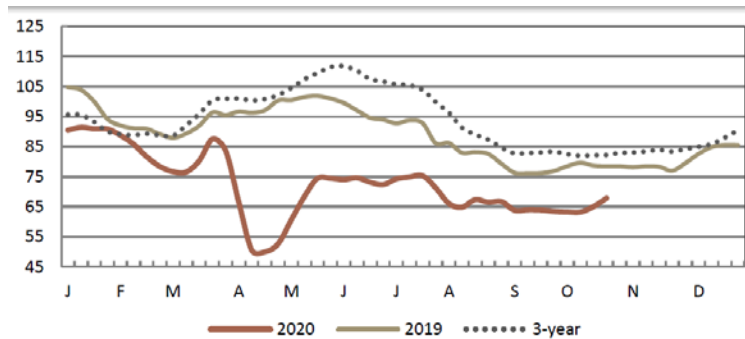

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 224 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 10, 2020, up 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.3 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down 3 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 177 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 10, 2020, down 3 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 4, 2020 through October 10, 2020 for the United States were 7.61 billion. Cumulative placements were down 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 21-Nov-20 is estimated at 157.3 million head. This compares to 159.4 million head the previous week and to 170.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 176.7 million head and the national weighted average price was 78.71 cents per pound.
