



# BROILER MARKET NEWS REPORT

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Livestock, Poultry & Grain Market News

### National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices are generally trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are moderate for current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is mostly moderate. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Floor stocks are sufficient. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, prices are firm for tenders, boneless skinless breasts, and wings. Bone-in breasts, dark meat items, and the remainder of parts range steady to firm. Offerings of boneless skinless breasts, wings, and tenders remain tight to instances short. Bone-in breasts and dark meat cuts are light to moderate with leg quarters clearing satisfactorily due to increased export interest, and the balance of parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate to heavy. Weights are mixed, but noted as mostly desirable.

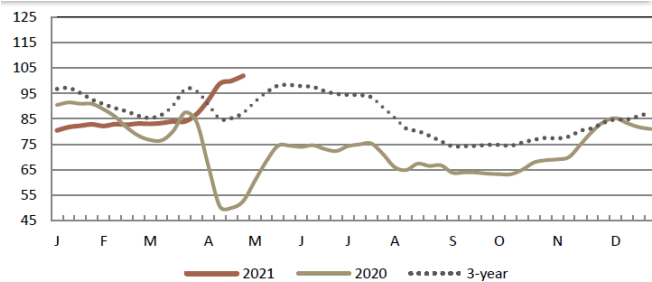

Frame prices are firm with trading at 15-20 cents FOB, mostly 15-17 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 10 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 17, 2021, up 10 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 80.1 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 6 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending April 17, 2021, up 6 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through April 17, 2021 for the United States were 2.80 billion. Cumulative placements were down 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.
