## National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to firm for most sizes. Offerings of all sizes are limited for current trade needs, with many plants experiencing production issues. Demand is moderate to active, aided by increased interest due to Mother's Day weekend. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Floor stocks are balanced to short. Market activity is moderate to active. In the parts structure, prices remain firm for wings, boneless skinless breasts, thigh meat, and tenders. All other parts range steady to firm. Offerings of boneless skinless breasts, wings, thigh meat, and tenders are tight and difficult to acquire, with premiums being paid. The remainder of dark meat cuts are light to moderate with increased export interest noted, and the balance of parts are mostly moderate. Market activity for parts is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are light to moderate. Weights are mixed, but noted as mostly desirable.

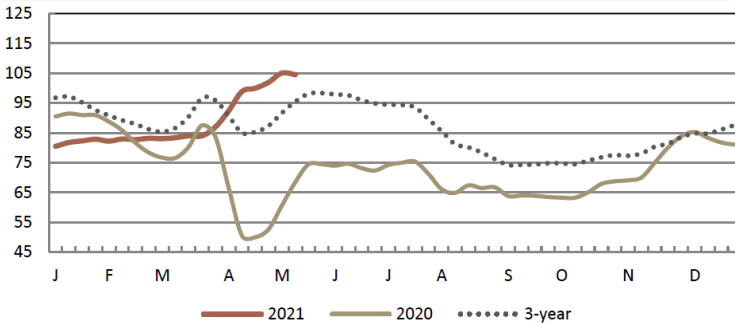

Processors are assessing upcoming needs with Memorial Day a few weeks away. Schedules are mostly normal to less than normal. Market activity is moderate. Supplies of raw materials remain tight for current needs. Frame prices are firm with trading at 17-25 cents FOB, mostly 18-20 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 10 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 238 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 1, 2021, up 10 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.7 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 9 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending May 1, 2021, up 9 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through May 1, 2021 for the United States were 3.17 billion. Cumulative placements were down 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 12-Jun-21 is estimated at 163.3 million head. This compares to 164.3 million head the previous week and to 171.7 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 164.0 million head and the national weighted average price was 60.63 cents per pound.
