National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance


Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady to weak for all sizes. Offerings are moderate to heavy in the Eastern regions and light to moderate in all other regions. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate for current needs. Floor stocks are balanced. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, white meat and dark items are steady to weak. Offerings ranged moderate to heavy with dark items, wings, and tenders having some discounting noted. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mostly desirable weights.

Broiler Hatchery

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 219 million eggs in incubators during the week ending

October 5, 2019, up 1 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.6 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 5 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 179 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 5, 2019, up 5 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through October 5, 2019 for the United States were 7.46 billion. Cumulative placements were up 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Weekly Fryers Available for Marketing

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 16-Nov-19 is estimated at 159.5 million head. This compares to 162.9 million head the previous week and to 167.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 165.9 million head and the national weighted average price was 83.32 cents per pound.
