### National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance

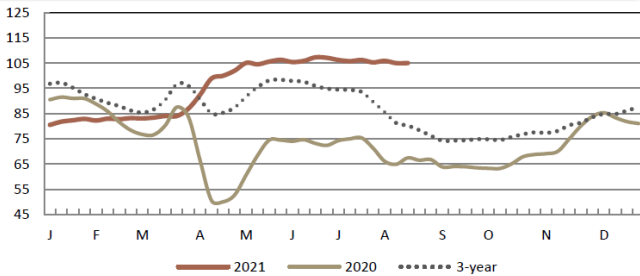
Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are moderate for current trade needs. Retail and foodservice demand are moderate to instances good for the approaching weekend. Floor stocks are balanced. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices are steady to firm for tenders, steady to weak for bone-in breasts, and steady on the balance of parts. Offerings of tenders are in good balance, and continue to move well. Wings, bone-in breasts, and dark meat cuts are moderate to heavy, and all other parts are mostly moderate. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but mostly desirable.

Prices of 15-20% MSC are trending mostly steady for fresh, steady to slightly lower for frozen. The undertone is steady to weak. Export and domestic demand is light to moderate and continue to be unaggressive. Supplies are moderate for both fresh and frozen MSC. Processing schedules are mostly normal to less than normal due to some operations dealing with labor issues. Market activity is slow to moderate. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady with trading levels at 9.5-12 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 5 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 31, 2021, up 5 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.8 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending July 31, 2021, up 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through July 31, 2021 for the United States were 5.61 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 11-Sep-21 is estimated at 163.0 million head. This compares to 163.1 million head the previous week and to 170.0 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 167.9 million head and the national weighted average price was 64.89 cents per pound.
