National Broiler Market-At-A-Glance



All other items are light to moderate and clearing satisfactorily. In production areas, live supplies are moderate; weights

Demand into all channels for mechanically separated chicken is light to moderate at best, while raw material demand is reported in a full range this week. Supplies are mostly moderate. Processing schedules were reduced in observance of the Christmas Holiday with schedules for next week varied due to the New Year's holiday. Market activity is slow. Supplies of raw materials is light to moderate. Frame prices are within the high side of last week's range and trading levels at 8-10 cents FOB.
