### [National Broiler Market-at-a-Glance](#)

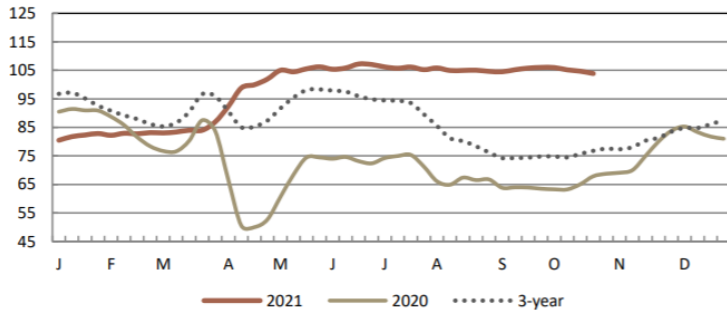
Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending steady for all sizes. Offerings of all sizes are moderate to heavy for current needs. Retail and foodservice demand are light to moderate. Floor stocks are adequate. Processing schedules are normal to reduced. Market activity is light to moderate. In the parts structure, prices for wings and dark meat items are steady to weak. Tenders and boneless skinless breasts remain weak, and the balance of parts are steady. Offerings of wings and dark meat cuts are moderate to heavy, with leg quarters, thighs, and drums in the longest position. Tenders and boneless skinless breasts are readily available, with discounting noted, and all other parts are moderate. Market activity for parts is light to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate. Weights are mixed, but mostly desirable.

Prices of 15-20% MSC are trending steady to slightly lower for frozen, higher for fresh. The undertone is steady to weak for fresh, steady for frozen. Domestic and export demand is light with buyer interest continuing to be unaggressive. Supplies are moderate. The initial phase of the 2022 contract season is progressing very slowly. Processing schedules varied as processors continue to contend with processor labor issues. Market activity is slow. Supplies of raw materials are moderate to heavy. Frame prices are steady with trading levels unchanged at 10-12.50 cents FOB.

**Broiler Hatchery**

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 231 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 9, 2021, up 7 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.6 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down 1 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 178 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 9, 2021, down 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2021 through October 9, 2021 for the United States were 7.44 billion. Cumulative placements were up slightly from the same period a year earlier.

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 20-Nov-21 is estimated at 156.1 million head. This compares to 157.8 million head the previous week and to 167.1 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 170.3 million head and the national weighted average price was 65.06 cents per pound.
