A20 Shipments into selected North Central States

1962 The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into 8 selected North Central States during 1962 was 7.1 million head. This was an increase of 13 percent from the 6.3 million head in 1961. Of the total cattle and calves received during the year, 2.5 million came through public stockyards and 4.6 million head were received direct. In 1962 direct shipments amounted to 64 percent of total shipments into these States compared with 63 percent a year earlier.

Receipts of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into these 8 States during 1962 amounted to nearly 2.7 million head, down 12 percent from the 3.0 million head for 1961. Of the total sheep and lambs received during 1962, 833 thousand moved through public stockyards and slightly more than 1.8 million head came direct. Direct receipts during 1962 accounted for 69 percent of the total receipts compared with 70 percent in 1961.

Monthly totals by State of origin for the direct shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and sheep into these 8 North Central States are shown in the following tables.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep Shipped from Federally Inspected Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during 1962 totaled 6.1 million head. This was 12 percent more than the total of nearly 5.5 million head inspected a year earlier.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards in 1962 amounted to 1.9 million head, 10 percent less than the 2.1 million head in 1961.
