In the slaughter cow supply, average dressing breakers traded 2.00 to 2.50 higher, average dressing boners 2.50 to 3.00 higher, and average dressing leans .50 to 4.00 higher. Slaughter bulls traded 1.00 to 1.50 higher.

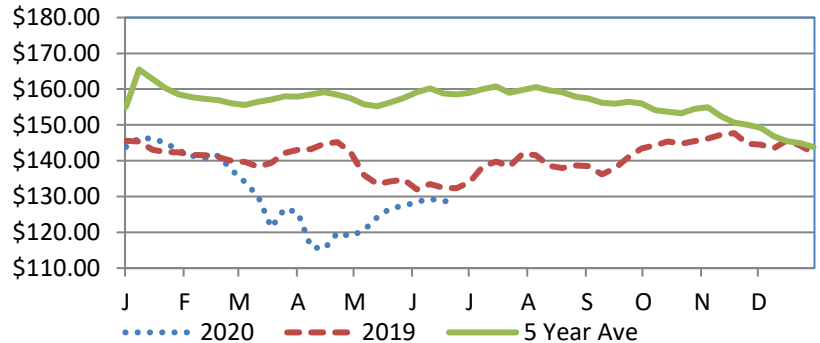
