**MEXICO CROSSINGS THROUGH NOGALES ARIZONA** Crossings 8-38-39 --- Movement expected to increase slightly. Supplies light and in too few hands to establish a market. The Sonora Grape Growers Association (AALPUM) projects 21.5 million 18 lb. (8.2 kg) cartons to be packed and shipped between early May and mid-July, 2021. This estimate is 2% less than the 2020 harvest and 11% less than the 2019 crop.

The largest volume is white seedless varieties at 44%, followed by red seedless varieties at 43%, then black seedless varieties at 7% , and the other 6% which includes Red Globes and specialty varieties like Cotton Candy. Between 3% and 5% of the grape crop is certified organic.

Not long ago 80% of the volume was three varieties. Today 40% is over a two dozen newer proprietary varieties.
