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EGG PRODUCTION AND LAYER NUMBERS DOWN:

Egg production during the year ending November 30, 1983, totaled 68.1 billion eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The 1983 production was 2 percent less than the 69.7 billion produced in 1982.

Layer numbers during 1983 averaged 276 million compared with 286 million during 1982. The annual average production per layer on hand in 1983 was 247 eggs compared with 243 eggs in 1982.

DECEMBER 1 INVENTORY NUMBERS DOWN:

The inventory number for all chickens on December 1, 1983 (excluding broilers), totaled 365 million, down 4 percent from the 379 million on December 1, 1982.

Potential layers (hens and pullets of laying age, plus pullets 3 months and older not of laying age) on hand December 1, 1983 totaled 316 million, down 4 percent from the 329 million on December 1, 1982. Of the 316 million hens and pullets, 88 percent were of laying age and the remaining 12 percent were pullets 3 months and older not of laying age.
