OREGON TALL FESCUE SEED CROP DOWN 26 PERCENT

Oregon: The 1976 tall fescue seed crop in Oregon is forecast at 7.0 million pounds, 2.5 million pounds or 26 percent less than year's final production. Acreage is down 20 percent from last year, and yield per acre, at 700 pounds, is well below the 760 pounds realized in 1975.

United States: The forecast of total U. S. production is set at 104.6 million pounds, 16 percent below the 1975 crop. This estimate is the result of combining the current forecast of production for Oregon and the July forecast for the eight Southern States. The average yield per acre is forecast at 240 pounds, compared with 271 pounds in 1975 and 253 pounds in 1974. The total acreage expected to be harvested in 1976 is 436,500 acres, down 6 percent from last year. This is 26,000 acres below 1975, but 18,500 more than in 1974. Estimates for 1975 and 1976 include Kansas.

CARRYOVER AND SUPPLY

Total U. S. supply of tall fescue (including Kansas) for the 1976 season is indicated at 135.3 million pounds. This is well below the 1975 supply of 152.9 million pounds. The 1975 supply estimate includes Kansas' 1975 production and dealer carryover, but no data are available for the June 1975 farm carryover in Kansas. Imports from July 1, 1975 to May 31, 1976 totaled only 1,700 pounds, compared with 10,200 pounds a year earlier.
