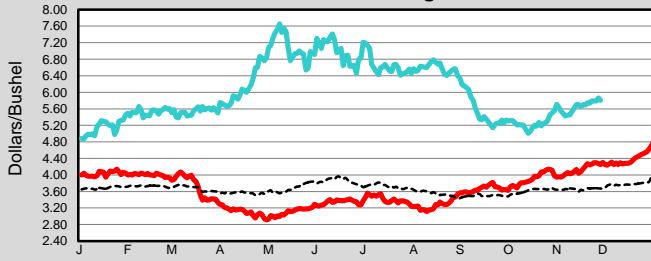

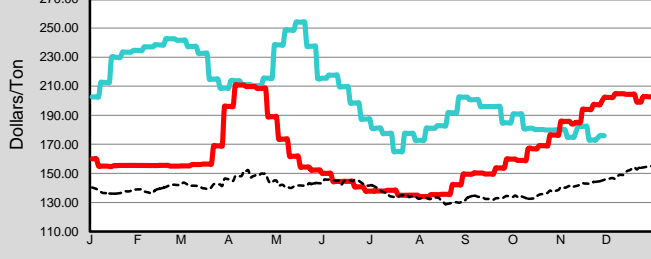
Eastern Cornbelt Corn Avg Prices

ECB Distiller Grains 10% Moisture Avg Prices



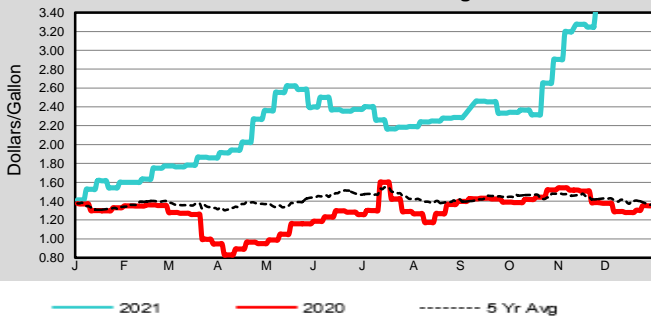

BIO-ENERGY REPORT NOTES

B100: Weekly spot bids FOB the plant reported as \$/gallon. RIN value not included in price

Delivered Distillers: Weekly spot bids FOB the export point reported in \$/ton, except for Texas Border expressed in \$/metric ton.
